The installation script is a bit crude, I've tested it and it does work but will only definitely install my system icons since these are standard. It will see if you have any other "semi-standard" icons (like DPaint) and replace those also.

IT WILL OVERWRITE EXISTING ICONS!!! So make sure you have backed-up any ones you want to keep.

Don't worry your Amiga will not go super nova. I take no responsibility if it does etc...

ICONS.

All the icons are my own hard work, I enjoy creating icons and tend to make around 8 "good" ones a month (well I am at collage.) I use 640x480 MULTISCAN PRODUCTIVITY on my A4000 and so most of the icons are drawn to look good at this resolution. I also have an A1200 using 640x256 - some of these icons don't look to good at this resolution so get a multisync monitor!

I'll try to do a 640x256 collection if I get any requests.

TEMPLATES.

These are the blank base icons I used to do most of the collection, some are my own design others, like the drawer, are MagicWB standard issue.

BRUSHES.

I have created many brushes myself and taken brushes from existing icons - I take no credit for such brushes! If you register you will get all the brushes for your own usage.

THERE IS ONE BRUSH WHICH I WOULD LIKE KEPT SACRED - MY ERR "<M>" THINGY - I WANT TO KEEP IT TO IDENTIFY MY STUFF SO THERE!!!

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS.

An OS 2+ AMIGA with an 8+ colour palette and preferably MagicWB.

1.6 installation

INSTALLATION.

Use the provided script or do it manually with SWAZINFO, ICON EDIT or similar.

The script will replace standard system icons mainly, but if you have a few

other drawers like "Data" then these will also be replaced. The script offers plenty of chances to abort the installation so you should be alright if you start it and change your mind.
