1.2 intro

These are some short docs for use of SysLockPrefs.

SysLockPrefs, isn't actually (as the name suggests) a preference program, this was the original idea, but, well, er, umm, ok, I'll admit it, I COULDN'T BE BOTHERED FINISHING IT! (Happy now?)

Instead, I just used the code making parts of the code, and used just these, (this was because it was NEEDED for SysLock)

Along the way I have added a few little bits:

Code protection - to stop just anyone adding a code

About Page - Just because (no reason)

Help Page - Badly set out, but what the hell

A small face - I just felt like it (click him)

I will go into details in the Usage

Whats it for?

Oh, almost forgot about that.

SysLockPrefs, is a program used to create codes for SysLock, without SysLock, its useless, if you have it, read on!

1.3 usage

SysLockPrefs is REALLY easy to use!

When its is started, a (nice!) GUI is opened with the following:

A Window (duh!)

11 buttons in a keypad arrangement, these are:

0-9 and and ENT key.

You will also see (disabled until correct password is put in)

Two string gadgets, NAME and CODE

A Save button

A Quit button

A Help button

An About button

A small face in the lower right corner.

I'll now explain the uses

The keypad is used to input the 5 digit code (Read on) I have given you when the correct 5 numbers are entered (and the ENT key is pressed) the keypad will become disabled (to stop you playing with it) and the 2 string gadgets will become clear.

In the one marked NAME, enter the new user name

In the one marked CODE, enter the new user code

When you have entered something into them, the save button will also become enabled, you can now save this name and code to the file called SysLock.dat is created, which has the encrypted names and codes saved to it, without it the program ends.

The Help button is badly set out (it was done in a hurry), but click on it for some help

The About button gives some basic info

The Quit button does something, but I cant remember what, give it a go!

And finally the face

The face doesn't actually DO anything, but I put it in anyway, just for the hell of it (I may put one in each program I make)

Click on the face and it pulls a face

The face can be turned off by the file being removed!

Oops almost forgot

The keypad reads a 5 digit code from the file mentioned in the tooltypes under KEY, if the tooltype is missing, it will use S:SysLockPrefs.Key This is not changable, and the password should be supplied, if it hasn't, well, to put it bluntly, your bugged!

And....

The face is on a file called (by default) Data/Face1.shanim

It is a 2 frame anim brush of 4 colours.... You can make a replacement with Dpaint, just make sure its the right size.

Or you can make a new one, with a different name, and alter the tooltype of FACENAME to suit your file 8)

Also

I have now added 4 extra face.shanim files, and a template, these are located in the same place as the original Face.shanim.

Load the template into Dpaint (or equivalent) and make two anim frames, use the top pic (without the border) as the 1st frame, and the 2nd pic as the 2nd frame, then pick these up as an animbrush and Save!
