Words Alive

WORDS ALIVE is available in two versions: DOS and Windows(tm). The program contains three state-of-the-art games that combine education with fun and excitement. WORDS ALIVE grabs your child's attention with colorful, fully animated pictures, popular children's tunes, speech, and a working clock. A Windows(tm) version requires a sound card, but a DOS version produces excellent quality speech using an internal PC speaker, and no sound card is required. Games can be played with or without sound and are easily adjusted to various difficulty levels, from letters and case recognition all the way to spelling and telling time.

As your child matches pictures to words or spells them out, the pictures animate and come to life. An egg hatches, top spins, train rides, and so on. A clock game can also be adjusted to an appropriate difficulty level and contains an interesting twist. As the child learns to tell time, he or she is actually solving a mystery word. When the word is spelled out and revealed, it animates. Children get the satisfaction of an immediate reward of a cartoon-like animation after every word, and often don't think of the game as educational. To them it's just fun.

Learn To Sign

A Windows(tm) version of Learn To Sign is an easy to use educational program that helps you learn, practice and review American Sign Language. It supports left and right 'finger spelling' and includes a dictionary of signs for some of the most commonly used words. It can translate any text file into sign language, and finger spell its contents on the computer screen. The letter and word quizzes assist in reviewing your knowledge. Printed personalized grade reports provide history of learning progress.

A DOS version supports most of the features found in the Windows(tm) Version.
