Buying and activating Salling Clicker

To use Salling Clicker for more than 30 consecutive "clicks", you will need to purchase a serial number from clicker.salling.com and activate the software from the Preference Pane. Activating the software requires an Internet connection. A computer without Internet access may be activated using a 2nd (connected) computer.

What's new in Salling Clicker 3.0.1?

- Fixed connection error when an incoming connection interrupts an existing outgoing connection to the same device.
- Added ability to set up some MIDP phones for outgoing (phone events capable) connections;
- Fixed Device Setup Assistant text wrapping issue;
- Fixed a Palm OS client issue when upgrading from an old version;
- Code signed Java midlet, allowing proper operation with Cingular-branded Z520a and W600a;
- Added some additional HP, Audiovox, Siemens, QTEK, Dopod, and Dell models;
- Added a "notes button" to select device models in the Device Setup Assistant;
- Improved ability of Symbian installer to kill off old versions of the Clicker server;
- MIDP/Java client: now shows a more helpful error message if no devices are found;
- Fixed empty visual keypad list for Treo 650;
- Added View Slide Notes menu item to PPT controller;
- Now compatible with old Nokia Series 60 devices;
- Added Nokia N70;
- Fixed GPRS issue in some Windows Mobile devices;
- Fixed issue with idle TCP/IP connections going stale in Windows Mobile and Palm OS devices;
- Fixed issue with idle TCP/IP connections going stale in network sharing;
- Help now works in Mac OS X 10.3.9 Panther;
- Improved support for hi-resolution displays in Windows Mobile client;
- Palm OS client now works over GPRS (for advanced users);
- Improved ability of scripts to simulate keyboard events;
- Worked around some UI-related issues with the W550i RTM firmware;
- Improved ability of Symbian installer to kill off old server versions;
- Improved operation with QuickTime Player;
- Improved operation with EyeTV;

- Improved operation with SlimServer (6.2.1 required);
- Improved/fixed Screen Capture functionality;
- Now works with DVD Player 4 (Panther version); and
- Fixed spurious issues in NetNewsWire functionality.
