### 1.2 features

-----  
FEATURES  
-----

ShowGUI is not only a picture viewer:

- ShowGUI shows pictures in a nice gui on WB

---

- You can also show pictures by using existing viewers + arguments
- ShowGUI got a picture list (like a playlist for pictures)
- You can edit and sort name, artist, type, date
- drag & drop pictures on the list/picture-browser
- customizable gui, allowing patterns.

#### Examples for USAGE

-----

ShowGUI is like a browser for pictures only. For example, if you have downloaded lots of pics from the Internet or from a CD, you can easily browse them with ShowGUI and bookmark those, you want to copy to your favourite location on your HD. Or just select those, you want to delete afterwards, or just browse them and delete the actual picture, if you don't want it, or copy it to a different location, or just make a nice database for presenting a slideshow or bookmark them for a collection of your favourite pics.

But ShowGUI is also a GUI for any picture viewer, that already exists. You can define external viewers with ease - you can also use TWO different external viewers. Show pics in the main menu with Multiview and watch them with MysticView from the bookmark list, etc....It's all up to your imagination! :)

## 1.3 install

### ----- INSTALLATION

Just copy the whole drawer to a location on your HD and copy the fonts to you FONTS: dir.

Don't rename any files of ShowGUI!

That's it!

### ----- REQUIREMENTS

Required:

- AMIGA and modern OS with lots of colors
- G4C (always the newest version) - included!
- XHelvetica.font (included)

Recommended:

- graphics card
- lots of mem (for huge pics)
- high resolution

## 1.5 browser

-----  
THE BROWSER WINDOW  
-----

On top of the main window of ShowGUI you will see some  
buttons (the button-images are located in the images-  
drawer and you can change them of course!).

OPEN

Load a picture into the main window of ShowGUI

SAVE

Save the picture to a different location

COPY

---

Copy the picture to your favourite location on your HD.  
You have to set the path for this location first. This can  
be done via the config!

EDIT

You can edit the picture with any paint program. Just  
give ShowGUI the path+filename of your favourite  
paint proggy and next time you click on edit, the pic  
will be loaded into the one, you selected. Configure  
the paint programm path via the config!

SHOW EX

This shows the same pic with an alternative viewer.  
Don't forget to define your favourite viewer via the  
config first.

CONFIG

See config

ABOUT

Some infos and a mad picture of me...:)

QUIT

Makes a toast for you :)

BOOKMARKS

Click on this button to open the bookmark  
list. See piclist

For the menus, read the menus-section!

There is also a string field, in which you can directly enter the  
path+filename for a picture. Then click on SHOW (next to the  
string gadget) and it will be displayed in the main window.  
This is of good use, if you have lots of pictures, called 1.jpg,  
2.jpg, 3.jpg, etc..it's much faster to replace this manually than  
having to wait for the filerequester to open again.;

## 1.6 menus

-----  
MENUS  
-----

ShowGUI doesn't have many menu items...

SHOWGUI

Here you can load and save a picture, iconify  
ShowGUI or can have a look at the ABOUT

---

window, if you like ;)

#### MANAGEMENT

Here you can copy a picture to a different location. A file requester will appear and you just select a dir and the pic will be copied there...easy, isn't it?

#### DELETE

If you browse your pictures and want to delete the current one or others, select this option. It will open a file requester. If you select OK, the current picture will be deleted (There's a requester asking you before deleting, by the way). If you want to delete another picture (which is not currently shown in the main window) you just select it and it will be deleted also.

#### LHA ADD

You can turn your pic into an LHA archive with this option. But you'll need LHA located in your C: directory! If it's not there, ShowGUI will tell so with a req. A filerequester will open and you just select a path and a filename. A shell window will open telling you the LHA progress.

## 1.7 config

-----  
CONFIG  
-----

#### PICTURE PATH

Choose your favourite path for showing pictures here.

#### COPY PATH

If you select COPY from the MAIN WINDOW, the current picture will be copied to this path.

#### PROGGY PATH

This is for defining a paint program. Enter path+filename of the paint proggy here. Next time you click on EDIT in the MAIN WINDOW, the current picture will be loaded into your defined paint program.

---

## GUI PATTERN

Here you can select a background pattern/picture for most of the ShowGUI windows. Don't forget to checkmark USE PATTERN to activate it.

## SELECT VIEWER

Here you can select an external viewer and can also provide some arguments, if needed. For example, if you choose 'Visage' with some arguments, like COLOR=BEST, you can click on VIEW EXT in the MAIN WINDOW of ShowGUI and the pic will be also shown by Visage in this case...

## ARGUMENTS

See VIEWER

## LOAD LAST PIC ON STARTUP

If checked, the last loaded picture will be loaded again on next startup - so you can always find out, which location you have been browsing last time. So you can continue there again for bookmarks, etc.

If not, only the ShowGUI-logo will be show on next startup.

## USE PATTERN

If you check this, the selected pattern will be used, otherwise ShowGUI loads in a default, neutral and grey background, which is located in the 'images' drawer.

To save your settings, select SAVE...otherwise select OK!

## 1.8 piclist

### ----- PICLIST -----

If you click on BOOKMARKS in the MAIN WINDOW of ShowGUI, a listview will open, containing your piclists/bookmarks:

### SHOW

Shows you the currently highlighted pic of the bookmark list in the MAIN WINDOW of ShowGUI. This way it is very easy to browse through lots of pictures.

### LOAD

Loads a bookmark list into the listview

### SAVE

---

Saves the listview over the old one

SAVE AS

Save the listview with a different name

SAVE DEF.

Saves the bookmark list as default. So next time you start ShowGUI it will be loaded in automatically.

ADD

Adds one or more pictures to the bookmark list. A filereq will open. Just select one or more pictures there.

BOOKMARK

Adds a pic, which has already been loaded from the MAIN WINDOW of ShowGUI to the current bookmark list. It simply takes the currently shown picture into the currently shown bookmark list :)

CONFIG

See pconfig!

EDIT

Here you can edit the current entry of the bookmark list. You can alter name, artist, date and type here. If you want to edit a new entry just click on another one from the list and the edit-window will be updated automatically.

DELETE

Deletes a bookmark entry from the list.

CLEAR

Deletes the whole list

VIEW EXT

Here you can define a SECOND viewer for showing the pics with an external viewer like MysticView, Visage, Multiview, etc... Select the viewer via the pconfig!

## 1.9 pconfig

-----  
PICLIST CONFIG  
-----

---

#### CHOOSE VIEWER

Choose an external viewer here, like Mystic View, Multiview, Visage, etc...You need to select both the path and the filename of the viewer.

#### ARGUMENTS

Here you can add some arguments for the viewer. For example, you could write:  
MODE=DBLPal COLOR=BEST for Visage.

#### PICLIST PATH

The path, where you have your bookmark lists.

#### ARTIST DEFAULT

The default for the artist if the pics. You can use it if you only want to bookmark pics, you have drawn yourself. So you don't have to type in your name again and again...good for lazy people ;)

#### TYPE DEFAULT

Enter a format default here, like JPG, PNG, IFF, etc

#### DATE DEFAULT

The default date.

Press SAVE to save your settings, OK to use them only. HELP provides some extra info. (For those, who are too lazy for reading this guide! By the way: Thank for reading! ;)

## 1.10 tips

-----  
TIPS  
-----

#### HOW TO SNAPSHOT WINDOWS

-----  
To snapshot the windows of ShowGUI press CTRL + G and select SAVE!

#### SCROLLING PICTURES

-----  
There are two possibilites:

1) Load it into an external viewer, which provides stretching.

---

2) Select a very high resolution ;)

I didn't find a way to do this with G4C - but maybe there's a possibility...just wait for future versions...;)

#### SHOWGUI CAN'T LOAD A PICTURE

-----  
If ShowGUI cannot load a picture, it may be, that the picture is in a different BIT depth than your screen can offer. So, if you have a 16BIT screen and load in a 24BIT pic - it's a problem! Also, if a pic eats too much mem, G4C will complain with a shell-requester!

#### Examples for USAGE

-----

For example, if you have downloaded lots of pics from the Internet or from a CD, you can easily browse them with ShowGUI and bookmark those, you want to copy to your favourite location on your HD.
