Start Installation

Choose this command to carry out a complete installation.

You can specify the directory to which Cloaking Device should be installed. All files are copied to this directory. If the installation program finds an existing file with the same name in the destination directory, a warning appears and you can decide how the installation program should proceed.

During installation entries are created in the Windows Registry. Optionally, a icon group can be created.

Uninstallation

You can use this command to uninstall the program. Your system is returned to the state it was in before Cloaking Device was installed.

To do this, the Cloaking Device directory including all the files in it is deleted.

In addition all entries in the Windows Registry are deleted. If present, the icon group is also removed.

You should only use this command if you are sure that you no longer require the files in the directories to be deleted or that you have made backup copies.

Exit Installation

This command terminates the installation program.

Installation Files

During the installation you must specify in which disk drive (usually [A:](#) or [B:](#)) the first installation disk is inserted. If you install from CD please specify your CD ROM drive. If you downloaded the installation files, e.g. from our Web site, then please specify the directory in which the (extracted) installation files are located.
