dWiz® - The Clarion for Windows Dictionary Wizard

- *dWiz*? What's that?

dWiz is a graphical, point and click database dictionary editor and CASE tool. It not only allows you to view and edit dictionaries, but can also create screen layouts - all with a few mouse clicks.

- Graphical Dictionaries?

Tables (files) are drawn on the screen in boxes containing the column (field) and key names. You can optionally display the column types as well. Relationships between tables are displayed as lines drawn between the boxes. Dictionary, table, key, column or relationship attributes are accessible via the right mouse button - the appropriate dialog box pops up and the attributes can be edited.

So, it becomes far faster and easier to edit dictionaries. (Oh, and you can print the graphical representation of the dictionary as well - up to 10 x 10 pages large! Of course you can print a detailed text report of the dictionary as well.)

- But it gets better than that!

dWiz has comprehensive built-in error checking that ensures that your dictionaries are accurately designed with the minimum of field name and type inconsistencies. *dWiz* will happily analyse existing dictionaries too. (Did you know that the cookbook app's dictionary contains 15 errors?!)

- Wait a minute! What's this about creating screen layouts?

Yes, it's true - just by pointing and clicking you can have *dWiz* design your application's windows! You select the Form, Browse or Report wizard, click on the files and fields that you want and hey presto! *dWiz* creates a populated window in TXA format - all you have to do is go back into CW, import the TXA files and Bob's your uncle! There's your app! You may never use CW's own window formatter again.

dWiz comes with a wide range of layouts - for forms there's 'Normal', '3D', 'Shadowed 3D', 'Shadowed 3D with right-aligned prompts' and many more.

- How does it work?

Dictionaries and screen layouts are passed through the text import/export facility of CW - TXD for dictionaries, TXA for layouts. (Even tighter integration is planned - we'll be 'driving' CW itself before you know it!)

- Is there anything you haven't told us?!

Well, funny you should mention that! There *is* more! We plan to release an add-on for *dWiz* called the *dWiz Warehouse*. This version will allow you to store and maintain *all* your dictionaries in one file, and most important, to see which of your applications would be affected by those dictionary changes that our beloved users love to insist upon!

(By the way, what was dWiz written in? Clarion for Windows - of course!)
