### 1.2 Introduction

Introduction

zconnect.library is a shared library for easy processing of headers of so called ZConnect message buffers. It also offers several support functions, such as functions for creating date strings or message IDs.

For those who don't know what ZConnect is: ZConnect is a format like the one specified in RFC 822 ("Standard for the format of ARPA internet text messages") - but simply another ;)

Please note that the definitions of ZConnect are currently only German, that's why the documentation of zconnect.library is German, too.

See the zconnect.library autodocs for more details.

### 1.3 Usage

Usage

Until version 2.0 of the library, the maximum line length of a ZConnect header line must not exceed 32768 byte. This has been changed in version 3.0. The default maximum line length is now 8192 byte. This is also the absolute minimum line length.

Since version 3.0, you can specify the global environment variable ZConnectLib/MaxLineLen to set the maximum line length to your needs. I personally prefer the value 32768.

To set the ZConnectLib/MaxLineLen variable to 32768, you would use the following Shell command:

```
SetEnv ZConnectLib/MaxLineLen 32768
```

You should then copy the ENV:ZConnectLib/ directory to your ENVARC: directory. This way you don't have to modify your s:User-Startup (or s:Startup-Sequence, which you shouldn't modify anyway).

3.0, 23-Jun-1997: - Locale support implemented: ZCon\_GetZConStr() - implemented ZCon\_NewCreateID(), ZCon\_CreateHeader() and ZCon\_CheckRoute() - added **special note on usage**

4.0, 25-Jul-1997: - removed \*serious\* bug in ZCon\_NewCreateID() You must read the autodocs to stay compatible! - removed \$VER: bug in German catalog which prevented zconnect.library from opening it (it took me \*days\* to find that one!)

5.0, 15-Feb-1998: - removed bug in LVO table of the library (see "BUGS" section of ZCon\_CheckRoute()) - implemented ZCon\_QP2ASCII() and ZCon\_ASCII2QP()
