Welcome to SpellAll, the one Spell Checking tool for all windows!

SpellAll can check the spelling of any Edit or Rich Edit window simply by dragging the "Spelling Bee" icon from the tool tray to the window you want to check. Any other window may be checked by using the Check Clipboard Contents Now feature. SpellAll can also do As-You-Type spell checking, no matter what program you are using!


- ◆ Right-click the "Spelling Bee" icon  in the Tool Tray to change SpellAll's settings
- ◆ Drag the bee icon from the Tool Tray over a window to check it's spelling or check the clipboard from the right-click menu
- ◆ Left-click on the "Spelling Bee" icon to open the SpellAll console

Overview

SpellAll is a unique spell checking tool that allows you to easily spell check the contents of any window! Any edit or rich edit window, which includes Notepad, WordPad, E-Mail entry windows, and many others, may be checked by dragging the bee icon  from the Windows tool tray over the window you want to check, and releasing the mouse button. If the icon is over a window that SpellAll is sure it can check, the icon will look like:



If SpellAll is not sure if it can check the window the icon is over, the icon will look like



, in which case it may or may not be able to read directly from the window. What if SpellAll doesn't recognize a window you want to check? Just copy the contents of the window to the clipboard and choose Check Clipboard Contents Now from the menu that appears when you right-click on the tool tray bee icon. SpellAll will check the complete contents of the clipboard, allowing you to replace misspelled words, etc. just as if it was checking a window. When SpellAll is done checking the clipboard, simply paste the corrected clipboard contents back into your original document. As SpellAll encounters words that are not in the dictionary, it displays the [Word Not In Dictionary](#) window, allowing you to replace the word, replace all, ignore, etc.

Features

Automatic "As You Type" Spelling:

SpellAll can constantly monitor your computer to provide on-the-fly spell checking. Choose Spell Check As-You-Type from the right-click menu to turn this feature on. If you type a word that is not in the dictionary, SpellAll will alert you with a sound and/or a Popup window showing suggested spelling. See Settings for more information. SpellAll even tracks your spelling as you use the arrow keys, the backspace key, and the delete key to make changes to the last few dozen words you typed, checking each one of them as you go. (Note that SpellAll assumes you are in insert mode, not overstrike!)

Popup Window

SpellAll may be configured to display a customizable Popup suggestions window if you are using the As-You-Type spell checking feature.

The contents of the Popup Window are customizable. They may be set to include:

- 1) Show the most likely single Sound Like word
- 2) Show all words that Sound Like the word being checked
- 3) Show the most likely single Alphabetically Matching word
- 4) Show the Alphabetical Match list

Additionally, the location where the Popup Window appears on the screen is customizable. The possible locations are:

- 1) Near the mouse pointer
- 2) Any of the four corners of the screen

"Sounds Like" spell checking:

In addition to traditional alphabetical searching for a spelling, SpellAll employs a Metaphone algorithm to find words that sound like the word being checked.

Drag and Drop:

You may drag a word from the Popup suggestions window to any Drag and Drop capable program. See [Popup Window](#) for more information.

Tool Tray Icon:

The windows tool tray is the small area on the right of the Windows task bar (or on the bottom if the task bar is vertical) that displays icons for some programs, and the current time. SpellAll adds an icon, the "Spelling Bee", to this tool tray. Many of SpellAll's features are designed to be used through this icon. Click on this icon with the left mouse button to display the SpellAll window, or click on this icon with the right mouse button to display the [right click menu](#), allowing you to change many of SpellAll's settings.

If you make changes to the dictionary, SpellAll saves the old dictionary in a file called QuikDict.bak in the same directory as the new dictionary, QuikDict.dic. If there is already a backup file by that name, it is written over.

Popup Window

When SpellAll is doing As-You-Type spell checking it may be configured to display a Popup window when a word is typed that is not in the dictionary. See [More Settings](#) for help with selecting when the Popup window will display, what it will contain, and where it will display. The actions available from this window are:

Copy

Press this button to copy the word selected in the list to the clipboard.

Hide

Press this button to hide the Popup window. The window will also hide itself the next time a correctly spelled word is typed.

Drag and Drop.

You may drag a word from the list to any window that supports Drag and Drop.

Word Not In Dictionary window

When SpellAll is checking the spelling of a window and finds a word that is not in the dictionary, it displays the Word Not In Dictionary window. The information displayed and the actions available from this window are:

Not Found:

This is the word that SpellAll did not find in the dictionary.

Replace With:

This is the most likely spelling of the word not found. You may use this word with one of the action buttons, type a different word into this field, or select a word from the Other Choices list below.

Other Choices:

This is a list of the other suggested replacement words that SpellAll found. This list may be either the words that sound like the the word not found, of words that the words in the dictionary that are closest alphabetically to the word not found. See Alphabetical / Sounds Like below.

Replace

Press this button to replace this one occurrence of the word not found with the word shown in the Replace With field, and continue spell checking.

Replace All

Press this button to replace all occurrences of the word not found with the word shown in the Replace With field, and continue spell checking.

Ignore

Press this button to ignore this one occurrence of the word not found, and continue spell checking.

Ignore All

Press this button to ignore every occurrence of the word not found in the entire document being checked.

Alphabetical / Sounds Like

Press this button to change what words are displayed in the Other Choices list. The title of the button indicates what list will be displayed if the button is pressed.

Add

Press this button to add the word not found to the dictionary and continue spell checking.

Customize

Press this button to display the [More Settings](#) window.


Cancel Spell Check

Press this button to stop stop the spell checking process.

Help

Displays this Help page.

Right Click menu

Many settings may be changed by using this short cut menu. To access this menu press the right mouse button when the mouse cursor is over the tool tray "Spelling Bee" icon . The right click menu offers the following commands:

Register On-Line Right Now	Go to our on-line registration sight.
Enter Registration Password	Allows you to enter the Password you get from LeeSoftWare when you register SpellAll
About	Displays the About box , showing the ID number you need to register SpellAll
Help	Displays the help contents
Always On Top	See Display tab of the More Settings window
Spell Check As-You-Type?	See As-You-Type tab of the More Settings window
Display Popup Window?	See Popup Location tab, under As-You-Type
More Setting	See More Settings
Check Clipboard Contents Now	Spell Check the contents of the Windows clipboard, see Overview
Exit and Remove Icon	Exit SpellAll and remove the Spelling Bee icon from the tool tray

More Settings

Many settings are available allowing you to customize SpellAll to your requirements. The settings are available under the following categories, each with its own tab:

<u>Exclusions</u>	Select what words and word patterns SpellAll should ignore.
<u>Modify Dictionary</u>	Add or Remove words from the dictionary
<u>Display</u>	Adjust how SpellAll displays information
<u>As-You-Type</u>	Control how SpellAll implements <u>As-You-Type</u> spell checking

Exclusions Tab

Ignore Numbers?

Check this item to prevent SpellAll from spell checking words that are entirely numeric, such as 12345.

Ignore Words With Numbers?

Check this item to prevent SpellAll from spell checking words with letters AND numbers, such as 12bd34, and 12/31/97.

Ignore Single Characters?

Check this item to prevent SpellAll from spell checking single character words.

Allow Apostrophe S?

Check this item to allow a possessive case for any word that is in the dictionary, such as William's, the dog's bone, etc.

Ignore email Addresses?

Check this item to prevent SpellAll from spell checking any words that have an @ in them, such as Register@LeeSoftWare.com

Ignore Web Page URL's?

Check this item to prevent SpellAll from spell checking words that begin with www. or http: such as www.leesoftware.com and http://www.leesoftware.com

Modify Dictionary Tab

The Modify Dictionary tab of the Settings window allows you to look up, add, or remove words from the dictionary. Enter the word you want to add or remove in the box next to the heading Word To Add Or Remove. The closest match will be displayed in the list below where you entered the word. Press the Add button to add the word to the dictionary if it is not already there, or press the Remove button to remove a word from the dictionary.

Display Tab

The Display Tab of the Settings window allows you to control how SpellAll displays different items. The settings available are:

Show "Sounds Like" List Of Replacement Words

Show Alphabetical List Of Replacement Words

Choose one or the other of these options to control what suggestions SpellAll will give you for misspelled word when you are checking the contents of a window. If you choose Show Sounds Like List, SpellAll will suggest all of the words that sound like the misspelled word. If you choose Alphabetical List, SpellAll will suggest words that are alphabetically closest to the word that is misspelled.

Show How Many Words In Alphabetical List

Enter the number of alphabetically closest suggestions you would like to see. Enter a number between 5 and 100.

Console Always On Top

Check this item to keep the SpellAll window on top of all other windows during a spell checking operation.

Show Splash Screen While Reading Dictionary

Check this item to allow SpellAll to keep you informed of it's progress while reading the dictionary file when it first starts. Note that turning this off will allow SpellAll to read the dictionary faster.

As-You-Type Tab

SpellAll has the ability to spell check as you type in any program. SpellAll even tracks your spelling as you use the arrow keys, the backspace key, and the delete key to make changes to the last few dozen words you typed, checking each one of them as you go. (Note that SpellAll assumes you are in insert mode, not overstrike!) SpellAll has many settings that allow you to control what response you see during As-You-Type spell checking. The settings are:

Enable As-You-Type Spell Checking?

Check this item to have SpellAll monitor everything you type in any program, and report any words it cannot find in the dictionary.

Sound Alert / Popup Location / Popup Content Tabs

Choose one of these tabs to change settings [for Alert Sounds](#) made when a word is not found in the dictionary, [where on the screen](#) the Popup window is displayed, [turning on and off](#) the Popup window, and [what suggestions](#) the Popup window should show.

Popup Window contents settings

The Popup Content tab allows you to modify what the Popup window displays. The possible settings are:

Popup Contents - Show One "Sounds Like" Word

Choose this menu item to have the Popup Window display the word you are looking up and the one most likely match based on a Sounds Like lookup

Popup Contents - Show All "Sounds Like" Matches

Choose this menu item to have the Popup Window display the list of words that sound like the word you are checking.

Popup Contents - Show One Alphabetically Matching Word

Choose this menu item to have the Popup Window display the word you are looking up and the one most likely match based on an Alphabetical match.

Popup Contents - Show All Alphabetical Matches

Choose this menu item to have the Popup Window display the list of words that alphabetically match the word you are checking.

Popup Window location settings

The Popup Location tab allows you to select where on the screen you would like the Popup window to appear. The possible settings are:

Show a Popup Window With Suggested Spellings?

Check this item to turn the Popup window feature on.

Popup Location - Display Near Mouse Cursor

Choose this menu item to have the Popup Window appear near the mouse pointer.

Popup Location - Display In Upper Left / Upper Right / Lower Left / Lower Right Corner

Choose the menu item corresponding to the corner where you would like the Popup Window to appear.

Sounds settings

The Sound Alert tab allows you to select what sound SpellAll will make when it encounters a word not found in the dictionary during As-You-Type spell checking. You may also turn the Alert Soun off. The actual sound associated with each of the selections may be adjusted by choosing the Sounds icon in the Windows Control Panel. The settings possible from the Sound Alert tab are:

Sound An Alert?

Check this item if you want SpellAll to sound an alert every time it finds a misspelled word during As-You-Type spell checking.

Select Sound

Windows Asterisk - Check this item to have SpellAll use the sound defined as Asterisk, under Sounds from the Windows Control Panel.

Windows Exclamation - Check this item to use the sound defined as Exclamation, under Sounds from the Windows Control Panel.

Windows Question - Check this item to use the sound defined as Question, under Sounds from the Windows Control Panel.

Windows OK Sound - Check this item to use the sound defined as OK, under Sounds from the Windows Control Panel.

No Help Available

No help is available for this area of the window.

UnInstall SpellAll

To uninstall SpellAll, use Add/Remove Program from the Windows Control Panel. Select "SpellAll 1.0" and press the Add/Remove button.

Re-Install SpellAll

When upgrading your computer system, you may find it necessary to re-install SpellAll on a new computer, a new hard drive, etc. This is allowable, as long as the new installation is for the same user as the original installation. The Password supplied by LeeSoftWare when you registered SpellAll will continue to work, providing that when you re-install Windows you enter the same User Name as you had used for your previous Windows installation.

The ID number generated by SpellAll, and the corresponding Password, is based on the User Name entered when Windows is installed. If when upgrading your hardware, or re-installing the operating system, you enter this name differently, the password supplied to you will no longer work, and you will need to contact LeeSoftWare for a new password. New password requests are usually answered within 24 hours if sent by e-mail. Of course, if when you re-install Windows you enter the same User Name as you had used for your previous Windows installation, the old password will still work when you re-install SpellAll on your new hardware and/or operating system. Remember, one registration is good for one user, let your friends and co-workers pay for their own copy!

Register SpellAll

SpellAll Spelling Dictionary is a shareware program. It is NOT FREE! If you use it, please register it.

Important!!

To register SpellAll you MUST INCLUDE the unique Id number for your copy of the program. This number may be found in the About box, which is displayed by right-clicking the tool tray icon, and selecting About. After you have been using this program for 30 days, you will be reminded to register it if you have not already done so. This reminder screen also shows the unique Id number you must send to receive your password. Of course, you must also send the registration fee of \$24 for version 1.0 of SpellAll! Once we receive your ID Number, usually within 24 hours of your online registration, we will send you your password. For fastest service make sure to include your email address, otherwise we must send your password by regular mail.

Fast and Easy:

The fastest and easiest way to register SpellAll is by clicking the menu item Register On-Line Right Now from the menu that appears when you right-click on the SpellAll icon in the Windows Tool Tray. This will take you to our on-line registration sight where you can choose what service to use to register, including a Secure server.
