

FaJo XP File Security Extension

FaJo XP File Security Extension (called FSE) is an extension to the context menu provided in the Windows Explorer for files and directories. With this extension you are able to directly view and change the file access rights (NTFS only) and ownership. FSE therefore uses buildin features that are available on Windows 2000, XP (even HP Home).

FSE will run on Windows 2000 and XP (or higher) only – including Windows XP Home. To install FSE you will need administrative rights. After successful installation an additional entry "Change security" will show up in the context menu of files and directories. In addition to the menu entry a property sheet is added to the property page of the objects.

Please notice, that You are using FSE on your own risk.

Please close any running applications before You continue to install FSE.
