1.3 Intro:

Intro:

Basically this is a tool where you can set A Listview to hold as
many Lines of text you need.

you double click the ListItem to set the Current Clipboard.

Then you can press the Right_Amiga-V to Paste the text into anywhere possible

Using the Characters '%n' causes a LineFeed <Return>

This was originally written For AmIRC to be able to store preset Texts
(Like it's FKey Settings) and Paste into the window with ease.

Now i've added a few features like ..

Prefs file argument/Tooltype: to load a different config at startup.

A chooser gadget lets you cycle to different lists (up to 37 Pages)

Append MUI textstyles (colour Bold ect) to Texts

Bubble Help instead of Screen TitleBar

Saving Settings Saves ...
Window positions.

Current Page position.

If an item is selected this is remembered and auto pasted at each startup.
Also take 2 minutes to read Important things to know:

Important things to know:

For AmIRC if AmIRC is already running and you don't have Clipper installed
you will have to reload in order to see Clipper.amirx in the Menus

ALSO.

I added a function to insert MUI TextInput codes (colour Bold ect)

Due to a restriction i cannot get a cursor position of the text gadget
to "insert" text at cursor pos (it's added to the end of the text)

ALSO.

You MUST press <return> after entering ANY text (not the menu inserts)
or Changes will be erased

1.5 Running Clipper

Running from WB:

Just double click the icon and away you go :)

Running from CLI:

Currently there is 1 argument that can be supplied

Syntax: rx Clipper <filename>

if filename is omitted then S:ClipPrefs/Clipper.cfg is used
rx is optional as the script flag is set
you'd probably want to use

"run >nil: Clipper"
OR "run >nil: Clipper s:ClipPrefs/another.cfg"

1.6 Usage

Usage:

Double Click a text to set the clipboard.

Select Show Edit Gadgets from the menu to edit the GUI

See Prefs for how to configure

1.7 Configuration

Configuring Clipper

Saving prefs also saves the Window Dimentions , selected page,
Edit status, and Selected List position

To UN-Select a List just click the Page Gadget and item is De-selected
either use the menus or the small popup gedget (lower Right above string)
to Hide or Show the Edit Gadgets
