## 1.3 Requirements

MagicSelector should run on any Amiga system with at least 512K RAM.

KickStart v3.0 or greater

asl.library

datatype.library

8SVX datatype

MUImaster.library V2.2+

MUI-Classes

Sys:Prefs/WBPattern

sys:Prefs/Sound

I have not included MUI since this would have made the archive a lot bigger. If the MUI-package is not yet in your possession, you should be able to find it at several Public Domain sites around the world, your local BBS or on Public Domain Disks.

## 1.5 MagicSelector Preferences

The MagicSelector Preferences is splittet into Pattern and Sound. I will only explain Pattern since sound setting is the same.

The MagicSelector have two differente methods to select an background:

Select Mode: Sequence ;Next Background in the list.

Random ;Random Background from the list.

Remapping: I am using WBPattern to change the Background. You can then select if the WBPattern program shall remap you background to the allready selected palette or not.

ListView: WorkBench

Windows

Screen

Add: Add an background to the list.

Remove: Remove an background from the list.

If you want to remove an entry, select entry and press remove.

Save: Save Changes

Cancel: Discard Changes

DoubleClick on an Entry for preview, You must have Multiview at this path:

SYS:Utilities/MultiView

PS!, MagicSelector preferences do NOT check the files you are inserting in the list, so you should not try to select other files than you have datatypes for (OS3.0) or IFF files.

## 1.6 MagicSelector

This program must be in WBStartup or in you Startup-sequence(User-start). There is no arguments or anything other thing you can do with it.

It is picking backgrounds and a sound from the list you have generated with the preferences program. If the list is empty or the listfile is missing it does nothing.
