

This CD-ROM is organized into fonts for the IBM compatible PC and fonts for the Macintosh. This file explains what is in the "PC" directory. Consult the "READ_MAC.TXT" for information on the "Mac" folder.

The "PC" directory is organized in the following manner.

* Font Viewer -

If you have windows, you should start by :

- * change to the drive that is your CD-ROM: type "e:", where e is the drive letter assigned to your CD-ROM drive.

- * change directories into the PC directory, type "cd \pc"

- * decide if you want to install a convenient icon into windows or run without installing anything.

 - to install the icon type "VWR_WIN"

 - to run without installing anything, type: "VWR_DOS"

THE FONT VIEWER DOES NOT INSTALL FONTS - BUT IT DOES LET YOU PREVIEW THE FONTS AND READ ABOUT THEIR HISTORY AND THEIR USAGE.

* ALLT1 - A directory of the 150 fonts in PostScript Type One Format

A font that has a screen font, AFM metrics file and a printer font. (Works with PostScript printers and ATM)

* BYFAMT1 - A directory of the 150 fonts in PostScript Type One Format

Organized into font family directories.

Same files as ALLT1, with a different organization.

* ALLTT - A directory of the 150 fonts in TRUETYPE Format

A font that has the screen font and printer font both in the same file. Requires Windows!

* BYFAMTT - A directory of the 150 fonts in TRUETYPE Format

Organized into font family directories.

Same files as ALLTT, with a different organization.

* BONUS - A directory of the over 30 additional fonts.

* AFM and CFG_INF - ".INF" and ".CFG" support files for the fonts.

* _RUNTIME - support files for the WINDOWS font viewer .
