

Delphi Explorer

The painless way to browse the object hierarchy of VCL, OWL, or Turbo Vision.

Select File|Options or click the "O" button on the speedbar to get the Options Dialog.

Select File|Update or click the "U" button on the speedbar to get the Update Dialog.

To Use:

Type an object or class name in the combobox on the left. You will be able to see that object's parentage in the listbox on the right. The edit control on the bottom right contains the name of the unit that the highlighted object is contained in. Click on the eyecon to view that unit.

VCL, or Visual Class Library, is the class library used in Borland Delphi for Windows.

OWL, or Object Windows Library, is the object library for Borland Pascal for Windows.

Options

In this dialog, you can configure...

1. The path to the Delphi and BP source code. Delphi Explorer assumes the default subdirectories from this path.
2. Your favorite text editor. This is the editor you will use to browse large files.
3. Whether or not you wish to have bubble help on the Delphi Explorer toolbar.

Update

This dialog allows you to re-parse the VLC, OWL, or TV source code in order to build new lists for Delphi Explorer. This is only necessary if the source code has changed or if the old files have become lost or corrupted.

Turbo Vision

The object library for DOS text-based BP applications.
