In the **QuickViewer**, you can:

paste.tiff ¬ ;ViewingAnImage.rtf;;¬ Open any file in the following formats and extensions:

- ;Whatis.rtf;EPS;¬ EPS .eps
- ;Whatis.rtf;PS;¬ PS .ps
- ;Whatis.rtf;RIB;¬ RIB .rib
- ;Whatis.rtf;TIFF;¬ TIFF .tiff, .tif

251212_paste.tiff ¬ ;PrintAnImage.rtf;;¬ Print out the opened file in the NeXT way. i.e.:

- a. Print to any attached PostScript printers, typesetters.
- b. Fax to any G3/G4 fax machine.
- c. Save as a standard PostScript file.
- d. Preview it on screen.

Note;¬Note:

Unlike what you see on the screen, when printing RIB files, the resulting file will be exactly rendered as described in the RIB file. This is because the *N3DCamera* class used in the application talks to *Quick*

Renderman[™] instead of *PhotoRealistic RenderMan*[™], which *Quick RenderMan* only renders part of the RIB file, ommiting things such as Lighting, Texture, and Smooth Interpolations, etc. time consuming stuff.
