

# General Help

This is a simple example of how to use the Help object to add a help capability to your program. This Help object was adapted from the one in NextDeveloper/Examples/BusyBox. The one there is an excellent example of such an object, but it is not designed to be removed and plopped as is into another application. In the one demonstrated here, we have removed the context-sensitive capability, which was specific to BusyBox, and provided a simple, reusable Help object and nib file. The instructions on how to use it are in Help.m.

(In case you are perplexed as to where the examples files are, they are in the Help.app folder. Select HelpEx.app in the File Viewer and then command-shift-O.)
