

Auto Start

Automatically starts Surf Snoop with Windows. Runs in stealth mode, and is ready to begin logging. Activated when the "on" button is clicked (recessed).

*** NOTE *** This feature does not work in earlier versions of Windows NT. Create a shortcut to Surf Snoop, and place it in your Startup folder.

Text Log

Logs the current user, the day, the date, the time, the web page address (URL), and the title of visited web sites every 20 seconds. To view, click the Text Log "view" button, and the log will appear at the bottom of the program. This is a backup log for parents who have children that might find, and change or delete the HTML log.

*** NOTE *** The power "off" button must be clicked (recessed) to enable viewing.

Password

Click the “password” button to display the Password screen. Choose your username, and password, and enter them into the appropriate text boxes. Click the “save” button.

*** NOTE *** Please write down your username and password.

*** TIP *** Create a text file with your username, and password in it. Place it where only you know where it is.

Setup

Setting up Surf Snoop to run is as easy as 1 - 2 - 3.

1. Check the appropriate browser's (Internet Explorer or Netscape) option button.
2. Click the power "on" button so it is recessed (activates the logging process).
3. Click the "stealth" button to allow Surf Snoop to run in stealth mode (hidden from view).

*** NOTE *** While running in stealth mode, press "Control" + "Shift" + "S" simultaneously for Surf Snoop to reappear.

Hide from Task Manager

When Surf Snoop is started, it will be hidden from the Task Manager (ctrl + alt + del). Surf Snoop will still show in Windows NT but users will be unable to End Task through the NT Security Task Manager, for Surf Snoop will automatically restart.

Additional features include password protection, automatically startup with Windows, hides the program from the Task Manager (ctrl + alt + del), and the ability to run in stealth mode (hidden from view).

HTML Log

Power

Clicking the “on” button so it is recessed activates the logging process. Also activates Auto Start, and Hide from Task Manager. To stop logging, click the “off” button.

Browser

Check the appropriate browser's (Internet Explorer or Netscape) option button to select the browser you will be monitoring.

Stealth

Clicking the “stealth” button will allow Surf Snoop to run in stealth mode (hidden from view). Press “Control” + “Shift” + “S” simultaneously for Surf Snoop to reappear.

*** NOTE *** The “on” button must be clicked (recessed) to be able to run in stealth mode.

Exit

Click the “exit” button to exit Surf Snoop.

*** NOTE *** The “Off” button must be clicked (recessed) first.
