

What is Mail Them

Mail Them is intended for mass mailings. If you have a lot of friends or associates to whom you wish to send a quick message, then give it a try. It can send HTML pages with embedded graphics. You can choose between personal copies or Blind Carbon Copies (BCC). You can send an unlimited number of messages and attachments. Mail lists' management is extremely easy. You can create excluded lists of addresses. The program supports English, French, Italian, Russian and Hungarian.

The program works with the operating systems Win95 OSR2/Win98/WinNt 4.0/Win 2000.

About HTML e-mail

You can use HTML code. Mail Them will automatically recognize it, if the very first word in the message is <HTML> or <X-HTML>. When you send HTML code, you can embed pictures into your letter. These pictures must be located on your hard drive, and you must attach it to the letter using the Attachments tab. You can refer to these pictures from your HTML code using the cid keyword followed by the colon and the file name (without path). For example:

```
<img src=cid:mailthem.gif>
```

- **In this case the picture will travel with your e-mails.**

Tab 'Message'

- In the field 'Subject' - subject of the letter (optional field)
- Under the field 'Subject' the body of the letter, i.e. your message (optional field)
- 'Attachment' - in it the attached files are displayed.
- 'Add' - to attach file.
- 'Remove' - to remove file.
- 'Open' - allows inserting of pre-prepared text into the body of the letter. The file should be in ASCII format. For example such files can be created in Windows Notepad.
- 'Save' allows saving of your message. By default in a folder Messages.
- 'Clear' - clears message.
- 'Word Wrap' - Wrapping text makes all the text visible on the screen

Tab 'Addresses'

- In the left part of the window you can see tabs for mail lists and exclusion lists. All your actions using controls from the right side of the 'Addresses' tab are executed for the active lefthand tab (either 'Addresses to send' or 'Excluded addresses'). Please be careful when entering addresses, as the program does not check validity of email addresses when entered. The presence of at least one address is necessary or the program will produce an error when you attempt to send mail.
- 'Open' - allows importing of pre-prepared addresses. While import in the format "one address in one line" is the only permitted format, if you have any other format, you can change it, for example, using MS Word. With the overwrite mode selected you can replace commas with new line (or new paragraph) characters. The text with addresses should be in ASCII format. For example such files can be created in Windows Notepad.
- 'Save' allows saving of your mailing list. By default in a folder lists.
- 'Clear' - clears mail list.
- Under the title 'Input address' is the field for addresses. Input the address and press the button 'Insert address'. All addresses are in alphabetical order. To remove an address, locate it in the left field and press the 'Remove address' button.
- 'To'- text, which recipient will see in the field 'To'
- 'Remove duplicates' – removes duplicate e-mails from the list
- Move to excluded list – moves address from the mail list to the excluded list
- After sending move to excluded list – moves all addresses after successful sending to the excluded list
- How send
 - a) 'Blind Carbon Copy' – all copies are sent in one letter. If you do not see the message 'Sent successfully' then none of your recipients will have received the message. Much quicker than 'Personal Copy'
 - b) 'Personal Copy' – if you experience problems with BCC mode or want to send personal messages then use this mode.

Tab 'Options'

The information, which you enter on this tab, is saved automatically. Ongram startup this data is automatically retrieved.

- SMTP Server information

'SMTP Server' - name of your mail server or any other that can send your letters. Can be represented in normal text format or as an IP-address

'Login' - identification value of the user. Default value TmpStr. It is not recommended to change it. (mandatory field)

'SMTP Port' – port which is used to connect to SMTP server (default value is 25)

'Reset' - resets 'UserId' to the default

- User information

'Name' - recipients of all letters will see this name in field 'From'

'E-mail address' - it is the address where the replies to your letter will be sent on pressing the button "

Rely to author "

'Organization' – your organization (optional)

- 'Language' - choose language you prefer.
- 'Statistics' – shows number of letters sent during usage of Mail Them

Pop-up menu

The majority of the program's functions are accessible on a right button click. These are the functions: Open message, Open addresses, Send, Save messages, Save addresses. Also from this menu the command Terminate, intended to stopgram execution is accessible in case of unwanted behavior.

For fields that allow entering or editing text (message window, subject etc) popup menu will allow using text operations like cut, copy and paste.

Registration

Mail Them is FREE. It doesn't have an expiration date or disabled features. **No registration is required.**

However, the program shows in the last line of messages request not to send Spam. If this behaviour irritates you can register Mail Them. Registration fee is \$19.95

2. In addition, you can send us the check (contact us for more details).

You can also use the wire transfer to our bank account (contact us for more details) On payment approval (usually, in one-two business days), we'll send you the registration key which will remove all limitations of unregistered version such as nag screens and limitations of addresses number. Your registration will be valid for all future versions of Mail Them.

Quick Start

- Enter your personal information on the 'Options' tab
- Load or create your message on the 'Message' tab
- Load or create your mail list on the 'addresses' tab
- Check 'Blind Carbon Copy' or 'Personal Copy' on the addresses tab. Enter your SMTP server on the 'Options tab'
- Press 'Send!'

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Why do we have anti spam line in our messages? How to remove it?

You need to register the program to remove it.

2. What is SMTP server?

SMTP means -a mail server you use to send out your emails. If you don't know your SMTP you can contact your ISP to discover that. Please note, that some ISPs don't provide SMTP access by their own and also block access to all other external and internal mail servers

3. Will email recipients see a whole mail list?

In both modes everybody will see his own address only. You can safely use any of them. Your mail list won't be visible for anybody.

4. What are differences between BCC, personal Copy and direct delivery modes?

- BCC mode - uses your ISP mail server. Very fast. Letters are not personal.
- Personal mode -uses your ISP mail server. Slow. Letters are personal
