

Welcome to INI2Reg

INI2Reg is an optional tool installed by your request. It allows users of WFTPD, our more 'mainstream' FTP server, to upgrade to WFTPD Pro without losing any of their configuration information. It will read in the WFTPD.INI file (or any INI file, for those users that have used the 'i' switch to choose a different name), that contains all of WFTPD's settings, and it will create a virtual server with those settings. For those of you that have been running more than one server with WFTPD, using a different INI file and address/port combination, you will need to run INI2REG once for each file.

INI2Reg has one dialog only, where you will enter the information that was normally set by the WFTPD command line, i.e. the IP address and port to listen on. As with other areas of the system, you may enter a textual port name, for instance, "FTP", but the address to listen at should be numeric.

The server name will be the name that the server is referred to in WFTPD Pro. It can be pretty much any name that makes sense to you, but must not contain a backslash character.

We thoroughly recommend using the "Browse" button to search for your WFTPD.INI file - by default, it is called "WFTPD.INI", and is stored in the directory where your copy of Windows is installed.
