

Indexer version 1.1

What is Indexer ?

Indexer is an easy to use, windows based application that makes an Index of your Netscape cache. Netscape saves its cache in a directory, which will be filled with data from the places you have visited. The data (HTML documents, GIF and JPEG pictures, etc.) Will be saved in files named M0?????.MOZ. It's impossible to look and find documents in your cache. Indexer makes an HTML compatible document, which have all the files with their titles or Urls listed in it. Now you can just point and click to view a document, even when you are not on-line.

How to use Indexer

Indexer is very easy to use. When you start Indexer the first time, everything has its default values. If you want to see what the generated list looks like, do the following:

Click on the Start button. Indexer will now make a file named cache.htm. Now start Netscape. Choose **open file** from the file menu, and open the file cache.htm. And voilà, there is all files in your cache.

The generated list can be customized in many ways, here are the some things you should look at:

Styles

Here are the different styles described:

- **Numbers in front of items** All items will be numbered if this option is selected
- **Write items in center of screen** All items will be in the center of the screen or the table
- **Use real HTML titles** Real HTML titles will be used. This will slow down process, but it's worth it !
- **Use HTML3 tables** This must be selected if you want to use tables...

Sorting

Just click on the wanted sorting method in the **General Settings** dialog. You can sort by Name, by Type, by Size and by Host.

Tables

Indexer 1.1 supports tables. All table specific commands are in the **Tables** dialog. To use tables, you must select 'Use Tables' in the General Settings dialog. To select the things you want to include in your listing, click on the Check Boxes in the **Include** section.

The generated tables are following the proposed HTML 3 specifications, and they are fully Netscape 1.1 (BETA 3) compatible.

Note: You will need Netscape 1.1 or newer to use tables !!!

What's New with Indexer 1.1

- Indexer has now the ability to sort the items. You can sort by Name, by Size, by File type and by Host.
- Indexer can write the HTML title instead of the URL. Indexer goes through all HTML files and tries to find the TITLE section and when found, it'll take name of the HTML page. This will slow down the process a little, but it's worth it ! This is useful when used with the Sort by Name function.
- Indexer verifies that the files are on the harddisk. This should fix some error messages.
- Indexer supports HTML 3 (or atleast Netscape 1.1 BETA 3) compatible tables. You can have the Name, Type, Size and Host listed on the page.

System requirements

Indexer 1.1 requires the following:

- Microsoft Windows 3.1 (or newer)
- Netscape version 1.0N (or newer)

Some know bugs

If you are using an external viewer (other than Netscape) to view graphics, Netscape will give you an error message when trying to view graphics. The message says: **Failed to create temp file**. If you know why this is happening, please email me !
