MVMIXER.DRV allows the user to save certain settings to a profile file in the \WINDOWS directory (or your default Windows directory). The file is named MV.INI. These settings are accessed from the Control Panel as follows:

- 1) Start the Control Panel
- 2) Start the Drivers section of Control Panel
- 3) Select the entry "Spectrum Sound Mixer"
- 4) Next press the "Setup" button.

Setup options

The following options are available:

Inherit DOS settings

By checking this option, Windows will use the same audio mixer settings that were being used in DOS.

Restore DOS Mixer settings

If this option is checked, upon exit Windows will restore the DOS audio mixer settings that were being used when Windows started.

Save Windows Mixer settings

If this option is checked, upon exit the audio mixer settings used in Windows will be saved so that they can be restored the next time Windows starts. However, if the user has also checked 'Inherit DOS settings', the DOS settings will override this option.

MV.INI ======

The above setup options are written to the MV.INI file under the MVMIXER.DRV section. The following are the default settings for the audio mixer in MV.INI:
