Crayons for Windows 1.0 is intended as a fun way to introduce very young children to Windows and using a mouse in a graphical environment. Please see on-line documentation for a complete description of how to use the program. This program is being distributed as Shareware. You may use the program for up to 30 days after which you are asked to either stop using the program or register its use. The cost to register Crayons for Windows is only \$12.00 and this includes shipping charges. There is an online registration form that can be printed and filled out. After receiving the registration, you will be sent the full registered version of the program which contains 10 additional pictures. THERE IS NO NAG SCREEN TO REMIND YOU TO REGISTER after the initial startup.

Crayons for Windows 1.0 was written in ToolBook version 1.53, therefore it requires the runtime module for ToolBook 1.53. PAINT1.ZIP contains only the program files. PAINT2.ZIP contains the runtime files necessary to run Crayons for Windows.

The program file is called PAINTUR.TBK (ToolBook applications have a TBK extension). This file should be placed in the same directory where you have the runtime files installed. See INSTALL.WRI in PAINT2.ZIP for instructions on how to install the runtime files for ToolBook 1.53.

NOTE: PAINTUR.TBK can be placed anywhere you wish as long as you have associated *.TBK files with TBOOK.EXE (see INSTALL.WRI in PAINT2.ZIP) and the directory where you have placed the runtime files appears on your PATH statement in your AUTOEXEC.BAT file.
