Registration



File menu

The File menu includes commands that enable you to select a file and to scan it.

For more information, select a File menu command name:

<u>Open</u>	Select a file for scanning.
<u>Scan</u>	Scan the selected file.
<u>Save setup</u>	Save TextScan environment.
<u>Exit</u>	Leave TextScan



Options menu

The Options menu provides commands for specifying the treatment of tab and escape characters.

For more information, select an item:

Tab



Help menu

The Help menu provides useful information on using TextScan.

- [About](#) Displays information on TextScan.

File menu Open command

Use the Open command to choose the file you wish to scan.

File menu Scan command

Use the Scan command to perform a scan of the chosen file. TextScan will refuse to accept files with extensions '.bmp', '.exe' and '.gif'.

File menu Save setup command

Use the Save setup command to keep your TextScan environment for the next time. This includes window position and tab expansion.

File menu Exit command

Leave TextScan.

Options menu Ignore escape command

Use the Ignore escape command to cause TextScan to disregard text in a line after the escape character.

Options menu Tab command

Use the Tab command to specify the number of blanks to which tabs are to be expanded.

Help Index command

Use the Index command to access TextScan's on-line help information.

Help About command

Use the About command to display TextScan's version number, copyright notice and registration information.
