

WTouch 1.1 - a Win 3.1 Utility to reset Date/Time for Files

Description:

WTouch is a simple utility to reset the date/time stamp on a group of files to the current system date/time or whatever you specify.

Prerequisites:

Uses Win3.1 common dialogs.

Installation:

Copy to any directory and launch as you wish.

Use:

Click **Select Files** on the menu bar to bring up a file selection dialog box. Navigate to your target drive/directory and select one or more files from the file list box. Click OK to close the box and confirm your selection.

If you wish to override the default date/time, click **Set Date/Time** and fill in the dialog box. Some simple edits are applied to your input - only years between 1980 and 1999, months < 12, days < 31, Hours < 23, minutes < 59 and seconds < 59 are accepted. You can still enter a crazy date, but it's a bit harder.

When you've chosen your files and set the date/time if desired, click **DoIt** from the menu bar, and the date/time stamp of the selected files will be reset.

Disclaimer:

You use WTouch entirely at your own risk. Only you can determine its suitability.

Release 1.1: added option to manually set date/time figures, spiffed up display slightly.
