### THREE WAYS TO PLAY

This is an excellent way to obtain a large sampling of games against a particular opponent in preparation for a game.

Furthermore, if the Game Film option is selected in the Game Options dialog, a game film will be generated for each game played. With that, you can go back and watch any game that produced interesting results.
