1.4 Installation

Installation

Simply copy the entire UserbaseExplorer directory to Doors: or unarchive the UserbaseExplr archive to Doors: and you have it now installed :).

To get it on to the BBS, run it as a standard door, e.g.

Key: Function: Extra: Lo acc: Hi acc: Filename/Name/Dest/Path:

U 34 0 0 10000 Doors:UserbaseExplorer/UBE

Now you have UBE installed, just run the door and play with the menu, it's pretty straight forward. You can alter the screen that is displayed, the filename is 'Main.text', there are no other extra files. I would be grateful if you left the BBS advert in there though, seeing as I wrote it and everything.

Technical note...

UBE will load the entire user.data into memory for speed & efficiency, this means you will need enough free ram to hold the size of your user.data plus about 90k for the door. If your system runs out of memory, UBE will not even attempt to run (for safety reasons). This will work on Multinode systems.

the door, its time to check it out,

just run it and look at the menu. Try playing with some of the functions, it's pretty straight forward.
