1.2 Introduction

MBMan is a little program that can give you some informations about the commands in the C: directory. MBMan works exactly the same way as Man 1.21 by MAUI and MBMan uses the same Manual.txt as Man but MBMan is much faster. This is achieved by loading the whole Manual.txt into memory instead of reading it line by line. As a result of that you need some more memory to run MBMan.

MBMan was written in Oberon-A ©1995 by Frank Copeland.

If you use MBMan regularly or you have any comments, bugreports or you want to pay me for MBMan, even though you don't have to, then feel free to write to me (see address at the bottom of this document).

1.3 Copyright

MBMan 1.01 is Copyright 1998-99 Morten Bjergstrøm.

This piece of software is freely distributable but still copyrighted. Therefore you are not allowed to change the program in anyway and you are not allowed to remove or add anything to the archive.

You are allowed to spread this program as much as you like but you may not make any profit of it.

I cannot in anyway be held responsible for any damage MBMan may do to your hardware or software or anything else. You use MBMan entirely on your OWN risk.

It is allowed to include this program on public domain/shareware disks if the price of one disk doesn't exceed 15 Dkr (4DM, \$2).

It is allowed to include this program on CD-ROMS if the price of the CD-ROM doesn't exceed the price of an Aminet CD (129Dkr, 20-25DM)

Magazines have to get my written permission to include MBMan on their coverdisks/cdroms. If a magazine gets my written permission to use MBMan on one of their coverdisks/cdroms they have to send me a copy of that magazine including the coverdisk/cdrom free of charge.

If you are a ShareWare author and you are using MBMan then please send me a registered version of your program.

1.4 Requirements

MBMan requires OS2.1 or higher.

1.5 Installation

Just copy the MBMan program to your C: drawer or somewhere else in your path and the Manual.txt to your S: drawer. If you want to have localized texts in MBMan then copy the catalog file for your language to LOCALE:Catalogs/<your language>/ (At the moment only a Danish and a Swedish catalog is supplied)

1.6 Usage

MBMan can only be started from the Shell.

MBMan supports one argument:

COMMAND The command you want to know more about.

Press CTRL C to quit MBMan when running.

1.7 The Manual.txt

The Manual.txt has to be located in your S: directory else MBMan will fail. (The supplied Manual.txt is the same as the one found in MAUI's Man_mw.lha archive even though I am aware of some errors in this document.)
