Requirements:

- Amiga - A-OS2.0 or higher - Med2Xm Program - *.med-files to convert

1.5 Installation!

Installation:

Copy the Med2Xm-GUI directory, wherever you want to have it.

1.6 Menu!

Menu:

Project/About Programmers info

Project/Quit Quit the MED2XM-GUI.

Prefs/Load Med2Xm Load the MED2XM-Program (If you want to convert a File, yu have to load the Program!)

Prefs/Load Load the last safed configuration.

Prefs/Save Save the configuration (Saved options: Buttons, the directorys and the window-possition)

Control/Convert Same function as the Convert button. It starts the conversation.

1.7 Probleme

Problems:

1. When a filerequester get open while starting the Med2Xm-GUI, the Med2Xm-GUI.prefs file is missing in the Med2Xm-GUI directory. You have to install them from the original Med2Xm-GUI archive into your Med2Xm-GUI directory!
