If you ever need to change the display type, you may simply delete the file QZR.MEM and restart QUIZZER. This will allow you to reset the display type. There is a new menu style throughout the game. You may now us the arrow keys, the page up and down keys, the home and end keys or the first letter of any menu selection to move through and select the desired action or category displayed. Our OnÄline Users Guide has been expanded, and the onÄscree viewing module has been improved to help users find information quickly. With version 3.0 you may now load additional guestions to your game's master file without exiting the QUIZZER software. You now have a menu selection that facilitates adding additional questions from distributed QUIZZER Question Disks. We have corrected the misspellings throughout the software and question files and have intensified our editing procedures so as to avoid misspellings. Our apologies for those found in earlier versions. We have altered the way QUIZZER handles answers submitted to te entry questions. In the past we insisted on exact answers. QUIZZER has been modified to review and evaluate your text entry answers more liberally. For example, when we ask for lastname only, if you do put in the first name, and get the last name correct, this will now be considered acceptable. Version 1.0 and 2.0 users may use their existing question files with version 3.0, however they must first convert their older version files. We have included a batch file called CONVERT.BAT that will accomplish the conversion for you. Simply type the word CONVERT to alter your older files so as to be compatible with version 3.0. Note! Once converted, your files can no longer be used with earlier versions so please be sure they are backed up before you convert them. Version 3.0 no longer requires the files called QZRCATS.DBF or QZRCATS.NTX. These are removed if the CONVERT batch file used. These are still required for versions earlier than 3.0 so delete them only if you intend to use version 3.0 exclusively. 1 63
