INTRODUCTION

The Football for Windows Statistic Viewer was designed to allow the viewing and printing of league, game, and individual statistics for all teams. The Statistic Viewer is used to list the top rushers by yards gained, passers by completion percentage, etc. The Statistic Viewer cannot be used to view COACH statistics, since individual statistics in this mode are meaningless (nor saved).

The Statistic Viewer is registered when you register your copy of Football for Windows. Only a few of the topics can be viewed without registering. When you register your copy of Football for Windows, the Statistic Viewer will "know" and the disabled functions will be enabled.

INSTALLATION

USING STATISTIC VIEWER

When you first start the Statistic Viewer, a File Open dialog box will appear asking you to select a statistic file to view. Select the file you want to view and click OK. The statistics will load, and the League Records, by Conference, will be displayed. To view the other statistics, you must go to the menu and select WHAT you want to view. After this selection, the statistics will be displayed. See the topic <u>What Can Be Viewed</u> for a complete list of the statistical categories that can be viewed.

NOTE:

If you want to look at a different years statistics once you have selected a statistic file to view, select File, New (<ALT><F><N> from the keyboard), and the File Open dialog box will reappear.

PRINTING STATISTICS

Printing statistics is a breeze! It's WYSIWYP (What You See Is What You Print). To print statistics from the Statistic Viewer, you must first select the statistic that you want to print. Once it is displayed on the screen, select File, Print Screen (or <ALT><F><P> from the keyboard).

NOTES

1. Make sure that the printer that you want to print to is set as the DEFAULT printer. If it isn't you can change it in Windows Control Panel by selecting Printers, and changing the default printer to the one you want to use.

2. If you are using a dot matrix printer, make sure that you use the HIGHEST resolution available for your printer.

3. For best results, use landscape mode for printing.

WHAT CAN BE VIEWED

With the Statistic Viewer, 120 different "reports" can be generated. Depending on what statistic file you are viewing, a couple can be meaningless. For example, if you are looking at the statistics from the Greatest Teams of the Modern Era, looking at League, by Conference, by Wins would mean nothing since the teams are not in a "conference". The statistics will be displayed, but as we said, the results don't mean much. Listed below are the different "reports" that can be generated:
