#### **Synopsis**

Presented for your amusement is yet another cursor tracking icon. This one is a single large eyeball which watches the cursor as you move your mouse around. Includes the prerequisite blink and sleep features. Of course, those who prefer binocular vision can start a second instance of the program for a 'stereo tracking' capability.

### **Version Description**

<u>Version 1.0 (1/12/93)</u> - Initial release of program. (Due to bug this version would run only under 256-color Windows.)

<u>Version 1.1 (1/13/93)</u> - Corrected bug which would cause Version 1.0 Cyclops to abort with GPF in VGA.DRV when Cyclops was run under Windows using standard (16-color) VGA. GPF caused by inadvertent embedding of a 256-color RLE formatted bitmap in program executable.

<u>Version 1.2 (11/27/94)</u> - Copyright form was not being refreshed upon Paint event. This version corrects this oversight.

## Requirements

This software was written in Visual Basic 1.0 and requires the presence of the Visual Basic VBRUN100.DLL in your Windows directory in order to run. This DLL is not provided with this software, but is generally available thru most On-line services and BBS's. This software has no restrictions on where it can be located on your hard drive(s). No setup is required. Start the program via the Cyclops.exe file as you would any other small Windows utility or applet. This software runs under Microsoft Windows versions 3.0 and 3.1.
