1.8 Playing

Playing the Game

There are next gadget in the main window:

Bet - This will open **Change Bet Dialog** .

Shuffle - This will shuffle the deal pile.

Done - This will deal & change cards.

After pressing Done 5 cards are dealt. Dealing to the empty table costs you **Bet** . Now You may unselect some of them and pressing Done again will through your unselected cards (cover down) to the junk pile and deliver new ones. If it was your last change the messagebox (requester) will show you hand evaluation. If You got hand which is good enough you are able to double your win pot in **Double Dialog** .

1.9 Hand Evaluation

Hands and their evaluation

Hands and their victories are:

```
Lousy Hand - 0
Pair - 0
2 Pairs - 5
3 of a Kind - 10
Straight - 20
Flush - 30
Full House - 40
4 of a Kind - 80
Straight Flush - 160
Royal Flush - 320
```

There are also next special hands and their evaluation depends of preferences

```
5 of a Kind - 140 or 180
5 jokers - 0 or 320
```

1.10 Change Bet

Change Bet Dialog

Here you can determine amount of changes and jokers. These values also affects the bet. The Bet is Changes+Jokers. Maximum changes is 3 and maximum amount of jokers is 8.

f. e. If you have selected 1 change and 4 jokers, then $\text{bet} = 1 + 4 = 5$.

1.11 Hand Evaluation Preferences

Hand Evaluation Preferences Dialog

Here you may select your own evaluation about these hands.

I couldn't get information about the rules of special hands of '5 of a kind' and '5 jokers' and people has different opinions about these hands. That why this preferences dialog is added.

My honest opinion about these hands:

5 of a kind is almost similar with 4 of a kind. Therefore I have set 5 of a kind is lower than straight flush as default value. Also I think that joker is good card only with some real card, otherwise it is junk. So 5 jokers is Lousy hand as default.

1.12 Double

Double Dialog

Here you can double (or not) your win pot. You will see card turned cover down and you must guess is it small (A,2,3,4,5,6) or Big (8,9,10,J,Q,K). Joker is both and 7 is neither. Don't Double will pay win pot and exit the double dialog.

1.13 Loading

Loading and Saving the game

You may save your game by selecting 'Game->Save' from menus. Requester will open and you may save your game.

To continue your saved game select 'Game->Continue Old' from menus. Requester will Open you may open the game to continue.

NOTE!

To avoid cheating savefile will be deleted after loading. Saving the game is actually save+finish.

1.14 Saving Preferences as Icon Tool Types

Saving preferences as Icon Tool Types

are saved automatically on exit as icon tooltypes.

JOKERS - Jokers 0 - 8

Changing Card Graphics

If You are skillful artist you may want to replace original Card Graphics.

Destructive Poker uses normal IFF-ILBM-files (923*480). Colors may vary from 2 to 256. Color 0 in Card graphics is used as background color for window. Change **Tool Type** 'CARDS' in program icon to determine graphicsfile.

1.16 Key Short Cuts

Key Short Cuts

Gadget short cuts are explained by underscore.

Menu short cuts are explained in menus.

Keys 1,2,3,4,5 are for turn cards in hand.

RETURN - OK selection in most windows.

ESC - Cancel selection in most windows.

Use 'LeftAmiga + V' & 'LeftAmiga + B' in the requesters where RETURN and ESC don't work.
