- MUI 3.3
- Kickstart 2.0 (V37) or better
- MusicIn

Note: MusicIn requires an 68030/40/60 with FPU

Installation

Just copy the file MusicInGUI into your MusicIn-directory.

If you want to create an own dir for the GUI you have to set the tooltypes.

Tooltypes

Supported tooltypes:

(1) MDir

Directory where MusicIn can be found. Default is 'PROGDIR:'

(2) MName

Name of the MusicIn mainprogram. Default is 'MusicIn040.FPU'

(3) Priority

Here you can set the taskpriority of MusicIn. The GUI starts MusicIn at this priority.

The same arguments are also supported if you start the GUI from cli.

1.7 Usage

Usage

I want to give here a detailed description about the options of MusicIn. Please read the file MusicIn.doc which can be found in the MusicInpackage.

You can select the name of the file which you want to encode (input) via drag&drop. A possible outputfilename will generated automatically.

Save Prefs saves the actual setting of the GUI.

The Start button starts MusicIn. (You may have to set the name and path in the tooltypes . Default: PROGDIR:MusicIn040.FPU)
