My Calendar is designed to help you manage calendars, data, notes, dates, labels, daily notes and simple word processing needs easily and effectively.

This help file will aid you in learning how to operate the program and all of its features. You can learn simple and fast ways of creating and printing calendars, using graphics, entering notes, checking dates, saving notes, alarm reminders, holidays, a simple database, daily notes and a basic styled text editor that doubles as this help system.

SHAREWARE TRY-BEFORE-YOU-BUY

This is the shareware version of My Calendar. My Calendar is being offered in this way so you may try most of the features of the program before you purchase it.

Remember this is shareware. This program may be copied for any not-for-profit purpose as long as the startup screen, the disabled features, the password and this help file remain intact. When you pay the requested fee you will receive a password that will remove all restrictions on the features of My Calendar. Until you purchase the disk or enter the password the following restrictions will be in effect.

- 1. You cannot create any new setup files.
- 2. You cannot add any new icons to the calendars.
- 3. The calendars will print with a reminder.
- 4. You cannot print multiple calendars per page.
- 5. You are limited to 20 records in the database file.
- 6. The start/quit screen will appear.
- 7. You cannot print label records by category.
- 8. You cannot select an icon to use on the repeating notes.
- 9. You cannot open TIFF or GIF files for editing. You can open PICT files.

Print the order form from the shareware notice window for the full terms and conditions. Also be sure to read the warranty information in the Introduction topic.

NEW FEATURES:

My Calendar can add graphics to your calendars and can even edit bitmapped graphics!! You can set the size of the graphic area to use, select the graphic to use and even edit and save changes to the graphic. Be sure to read the topic on Using Graphics. In addition to opening PICT files, in version 5.2 you can open and edit TIFF and GIF files (and then save them as PICT files) for inclusion on your calendars!

Editing and using graphics requires large amounts of memory. Be sure to read the Introduction/Memory and the Using Graphics topics on memory requirements.

Be sure to read the other topics in the help file that explain the new features in My Calendar

such as; adding icons with repeating notes, the daily view window and printing daily view note pages. Also read the recent changes topic.
