This function can only be applied to a selected Address Book, and only when the Content list is selected. It will create a new Address and will bring up the "Address Editing" dialog.

New Folder:

Folders are useful for storing related Addresses. This function can only be applied to a selected Address Book, and only when the Content list is selected.

A new folder will be placed in the Content list, called "Untitled". To rename the folder, select it in the Content List and click the "Edit List Item..." button.

New Signature:

For those who like to end their Email messages with a quote or a bit of ASCII art, this is the place to store it.

o edit your signature, double-click on its icon in the Content list.

Send Item: ⌘I

New in InternetMemory 1.5!

"Send Item" is the equivalent of the "Insert" command from InternetMemory 1.0. Because IM now takes full advantage of the GetURL AppleEvents, it literally sends the address to your chosen helper applications.

Start Recording: ⌘R

New in InternetMemory 1.5!

InternetMemory now provides the ability to record your history in Netscape. After you press the "Record" button InternetMemory will switch to Netscape and begin to track your trail. As you go into different machines (i.e.: www.circldream.com), IM will create folders allowing you to follow back along your path.

Find: ⌘F

InternetMemory features a simple Find command that allows you to quickly and easily search through the currently selected Address Book. The "Find" dialog looks like this:

type your search string into the text field and setup your search criteria. Click the "Find" button to initiate your search. To find the next Address that matches the criteria, choose "Find Again" from the "Commands" menu (or type ⌘G).

Find Again: ⌘G

Find Again will continue to search through the currently selected Address Book, attempting to match the search string again. See "Find" above for more details.

Show/Hide Comments: ⌘I

The Comments window displays the comments and the actual Internet address for the currently selected Address in the Content list. This command will change depending on the current visibility of the Comments window.

Empty Trash: ⌘T

The Trash in InternetMemory works exactly the same way as the Finder's Trash can - they even share the same icon. Empty Trash is the same as the Finder's "Empty Trash" command, except that ours has a command key equivalent. The Trash can also be Emptied by clicking on the "Empty Trash" button, which is found in the Trash window.
