Once you've paid the shareware fee, you can go to the General preferences dialog and click on the "I Paid" check-box. Go ahead, you've earned it. Once you've done so, the "About" window will finally stop appearing every time you run Cron Setup.

The number of shareware payments received will, as you'd expect, tend to influence the amount of work I can afford to put into Cron in the future, so thank you for supporting shareware.
