What is WinPopUp?

WinPopUp is a windows utility allowing you to pop windows to the front without clicking on them. Just navigate the cursor to any part of a window that is not currently active, and it will automatically pop-up to the front, activated. Pressing the On/Off button will activate/deactivate this feature. Another way to activate/deactivate WinPopUp is to double-right-click on the WinPopUp icon when minimized (Try it now!). There are also options like popping-up MDI windows (a little buggy in this version.)

Options Available

There are two options available in the Options menu:

MDI Activation:

When selected, will also pop-up and activate MDI windows.

Beeping:

When selected, will generate a beep whenever an option item is selected.

Multiple Document Interface (MDI)
