

## **Remind** by Levi Nigg

This program is Freeware. It was written using Visual Basic 3.0 and requires the VBRUN300.dll to operate. GRID.VBX is included in the original ZIP file and should be moved to your Windows system directory. Feel free to distribute as you wish.

**Note:** If you are upgrading for a previous version of **Remind**, use your own **Remind.dat** file instead of the one included in this Zip file so that you don't lose your current data.

## **Remind V1.8**

This program was written to provide a small reminder program of upcoming events when starting windows. This can be accomplished by putting the icon for Remind in the Start-up windows group or by adding the filename to the Win.ini file in the Windows directory. The program was fashioned after a DOS program called Tickler.

The program automatically displays any events that are due or upcoming dependent on how they are added to the database. Depending on the date, and how many days in advance you wanted to be warned of something there could be a few, or no reminders given.

To edit the dates, simply click on the **Edit** button and the list of current stored dates are displayed. Clicking the grid on the selected date automatically moves that date to the edit window. Edit the information as you wish and then click either the **Next** or **Previous** button to save the information in RAM. To calculate new sequence numbers and redisplay the screen, use the **ReCalc** button.

To add dates, type in your reminder leaving the Seq. field blank. Use tab to move to different fields. Input into the column labeled "Warn" the number of days in advance you want to be reminded of the event. For an annual reminder put a capital A in the repeat column or put a capital M for a monthly reminder. If you put a date in the column marked "Ann" the program will display the number of years anniversary for the date. If you do not put in the year, just input a 0 (zero). At the end of each line of input, simply click on the **Add** button to store your reminder. Click on the **Exit** button when finished editing.

The complete database can be printed by clicking on the **Print** button in the Reminder editor pane.

To delete a reminder, click on Next or Previous until the selection is in the edit box. Then click on **Delete** to remove that reminder.
