You also have permission to use ADSTools to your heart's content as long as you don't use it (or Access while you're using it) to make money. If Access Development is just a non-paying hobby for you, you don't have to register it, unless you want to encourage us to write more shareware. If you use Access to earn money, and find ADSTools useful, you are required to register it by paying the authors \$20.

Double Click to Close ADSTools.

<u>Design View</u> Click with left mouse button to switch active form into design view

Form View

Click with left mouse button to switch active form into form view

Datasheet View

Click with left mouse button to switch active form into datasheet view.

Property Sheet
Click with left mouse button to toggle the form design property sheet on and off

 $\frac{\text{Field List}}{\text{Click with left mouse button to toggle the form design field list on and off}}$

Palette
Click with left mouse button to toggle the form design palette on and off

Ruler Click with left mouse button to toggle the form design ruler on and off

Grid Click with left mouse button to toggle the form design grid on and off

 $\frac{\text{Toolbox}}{\text{Click with left mouse button to toggle the form design toolbox on and off}}$

<u>Toolbar</u> Click with left mouse button to toggle the Access toolbar on and off

Status Bar Click with left mouse button to toggle the Access Status Bar on and off

Immediate Window

Click with left mouse button to Show the Immediate Window. This function is from the MS Access Knowledge Base. It allows you to REdisplay (you must display it from module view at least once first) the Immediate Window from anywhere else in Access. You do not have to be in Module view.

Database Analyzer

Click with left mouse button to Start the Database Analyzer. The Database Analyzer was included with MS Access, but is not on any of it's menus. If this button doesn't work, check to be sure that ANALYZER.MDA is in your Access directory.

<u>Help</u>

Click with left mouse button to view this help file

Return

Click with left mouse button to Return ADSTools to the Access title bar. Since Access does not have an event for the user moving or resizing the Access Window, there is no way in an Access library to reposition ADSTools automatically when you move or resize Access. This button reruns the positioning code and makes the toolbar jump back to your Access title bar.

Installing ADSTools

- 1. Close Access if it is running.
- 2. Add the following lines to your MSACCESS.INI [Libraries] section:

 ANALYZER.MDA=

 ADST2.MDA=

DO NOT add either line if it already exists!

- 3. If your MSACCESS.INI does not have a [Menu Add-ins] section, add one at the bottom of the file. Separate it from the last existing section by at least on line.
- 4. Add the following line to your MSACCESS.INI [Menu Add-ins] section:

ADS&Tools==adst InitDevSpeedTools()

- 5. Copy the enclosed file ADST2.MDA into your Access directory.
- 6. Copy ADST2.HLP to your Windows directory.
- 6. Restart Access.
- 7. OPEN A DATABASE! You must have a database open before you start ADSTools.
- 8. Click "ADSTools" on the help menu.
