Contents for Traveler's DataBook Help

Traveler's DataBook is a quick and easy information source for important travel information. It requires very little disk space, and is always available when you need it most.

I. Introduction

The Traveler's DataBook software will work with any computer running Microsoft Windows 3.x. The only other requirement is that 100K of disk space be available to load the Traveler's DataBook files.

Files with the extension .txt must be associated with a text editor/word processor. The Windows default is notepad.exe which works just fine. To learn more about associating files with applications, run File Manager and select Help from the Toolbar, then select Associate Files with Applications from the Contents page.

II. Installation

To install the files onto your system, from Windows launch the application INSTALL.EXE that is located on the Traveler's DataBook distribution disk or directory. One way of doing this is to load the disk into your A: drive. From the Program Manager, select the File Menu and then select the RUN command. Specify the command A:INSTALL and click on the OK button. By default, the installation program will install Traveler's DataBook into directory C:\TDB, but you can change this location if you wish.

III. Operation

The Traveler's DataBook is easy to use. Each type of information is identified by an icon in the Traveler's DataBook program group. Simply point to the icon and double-click the left mouse button (Alternately, use the cursor control keys and press enter).

You can maximize the window to fill the entire screen by clicking on the up arrow button located in the top right corner of the window.

Some information records are larger than can be displayed in a single window. To scroll through the information, use the up and down arrows located on the right scroll bar (Alternately, use the page up and page down keys).

IV. Personal Notes

The Personal Notes item allows you to record vital travel information which you use often or which you need to keep a record of. This can be priority club numbers, telephone numbers, travel itinerary, etc. Note that this is the only information group which can be modified by the user.
