File

New Account

Clears or saves current account and creates new account.

Open

Loads a new account into memory, and any existing account in memory is cleared.

Save as

Saves the account file as the user specified.

Save

Saves the current account file.

Balance Show

Displays current balances of each transactions. Bank and User balance is displayed separately.

Change Initial Balance

Changes current starting balances for each area of transactions.

Exit

Quits the software

Report

Checking

Shows Checkbook report

Savings

Shows Savings Book report

Money

Shows cash transaction report

Credit Cards

Shows credit card transaction report

Banking

Check...

Invokes Check dialogbox for check input. Enter check number - it can be either number or letters. Symbols or other uncommonly used characters can be entered as a number, but not recommended. The date must be in MM/DD/YY format (i.e. 03/14/70 is March 14, 1970).

Deposit...

Invokes Deposit dialogbox for deposits for checking account. Enter cash and checks separately by it's columns. The buttons next to each check entry is for future version.

Cash Machine...

Invokes Cash Machine dialogbox for ATM transactions. Enter Location of the transaction.

Interest...

Invokes interest acrued dialogbox. Input percent yield for that month and the amount earned from that percentage.

Withdrawl Savings...

Invokes Withdrawl savings dialogbox for savings transactions. Enter the method of money withdrawl (i.e. Cash, Bank Check, Money Order).

Savings Deposit...

Invokes Deposit dialogbox for savings transactions.

Cash Machine...

Invokes Cash Machine dialogbox for savings ATM transactions.

Earned Interest...

Invokes Interest dialogbox for savings transactions.

Money

Spendature...

Invokes Cash Spendature dialogbox for cash transactions.

Piggy Bank...

Invokes Piggy Bank dialogbox for cash savings transactions.

Credit Cards

Charge

Invokes Credit Card Charge dialogbox for credit card transactions.

Refund

Invokes Credit Card Refund dialogbox for credit card transactions.

Cash Machine

Invokes Credit Card Cash Machine dialogbox for credit card ATM transactions.

Interest Charges

Invokes Credit Card Interest Charge dialogbox for credit card finance interest charges.
Enter annual percentage rate and current interest amount.

Type Setup...

Invokes Type Setup dialogbox for changing the transaction types for the current account. Can also set the default transaction type when entering a new transaction.

Sort

by Date

by Number

Sorts the account transactions.

Graph

Pie Chart

Bar Chart

Invokes child window for displaying pie charts and bar charts. Currently, only checking account's expenditure transaction can be graphed.

Show Type

Invokes child window for displaying transaction types by color used for graphing and the total calculated amount of each type.

Hints and Tips

If you feel better to enter data like "programming" source entry, it's possible to edit the account (*.ACC) file to satisfy the need. Warning: do not alter the order of the each different categories. You may however can mix the order of the data entries for transactions. Before editing your (*.ACC) file, we strongly recommend that you make a backup copy of your (*.ACC) file.

Getting Started

To start a new account:

Please read this page to start you off in using our software.

First, make sure you have SAVED previous account if existed. Select **File | New Account...** then select OK. Select **File | Change Initial Balances...** and enter starting balances for each transactions. You are ready to enter the transaction data!

There are four different category of transactions available to you. You can use any number of transactions as you need, i.e. Checking, Savings, Cash and Credit card transactions. The data will be saved in text format under *.ACC filename extensions for in case of the data corruption, it can be hand edited to save portions of data. It's possible to enter data by editing account file, but NOT recommended.

The toolbars are buttons right below the pull down menus. It is only for convenience for you to enter data quickly. Not all of the menu choices are offered for toolbars because of space limitations.

The each transaction data is entered by dialogs. A typical data entry consists of reference #, date, to, for/memo, amount, details, and types. A default reference # and date is entered for you at each new dialog entry, you may change if it is not correct. Details can be entered, but optional. Types are different spendature category which is consistant through out each of the four transaction types. See **Options | Types Setup...** for more info. For more information about each commands for data entry refer to **Banking** **Money** **Credit Cards** help listings.

After the data entry, the entries can be viewed by reports. There are reports for each different category of transactions. For more information about reports, refer to **Report** help listing.

The entries can be sorted by date or by reference numbers, please refer to **Options | Sort** help listing.

One of the best features of data mangement software is to display its data in graphical form. BCS has function to do exactly that - you can see your checkbook transactions in bar graph or pie graph. See **Options | Graph & Options | Show type** for more information. Only checking transactions can be viewed graphically at this time.
