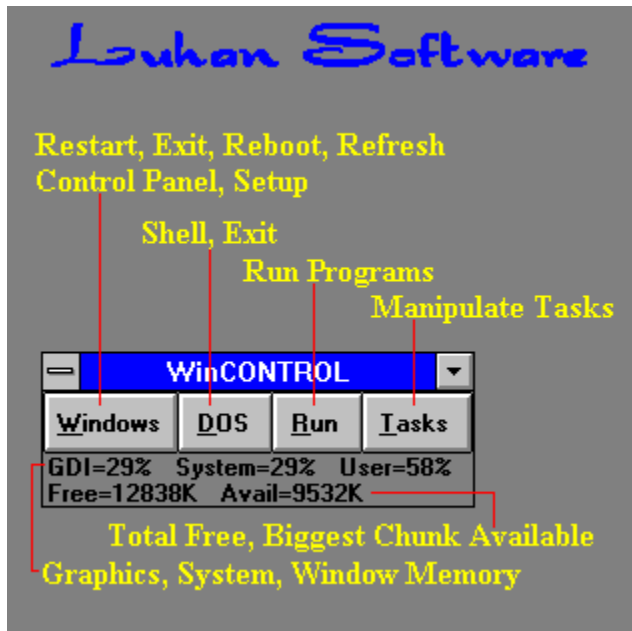

Windows



By pressing the Windows button you can have access to the following things:

Restart Windows

This will end your current Windows session, then it will start a new Windows session.

Exit Windows

This will end your current Windows session. It is the same action that the Windows Program Manager takes when you select 'Exit Windows' from the file menu.

Reboot System

This will end your current Windows session, then it will reboot your system.

File Manager

This is a fast way to access the Windows File Manager.

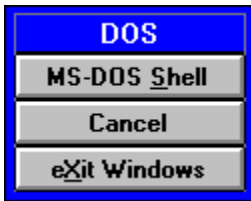
Control Panel

This is a fast way to access the Windows Control Panel.

Setup

This is a fast way to access the Windows Setup application.

DOS



By pressing the DOS button you have access to the following things:

MS-DOS Shell

This button will run a DOS shell. The first time you use this feature you will be prompted for the location of the PIF file for the DOS shell. Thereafter it will just run it.

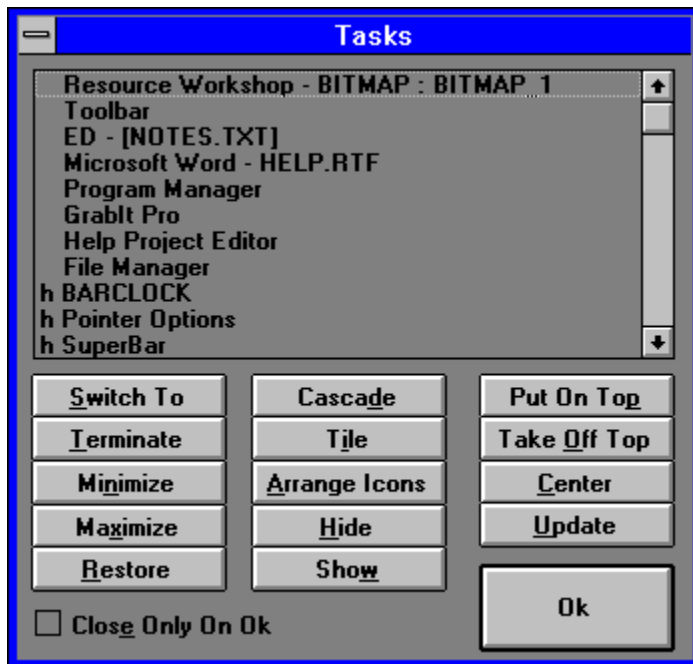
Exit Windows

This will end your current Windows session. This button is also under the Windows button. It was also placed here due to the fact that users preferred/wanted this option here. The logic was that if you choose the DOS button, you want to go out to DOS versus choosing the Windows button and exiting Windows to DOS. Either way you can't go wrong when you want to get to DOS in a hurry.

Run

This button will let you run a Windows program, DOS program, DOS batch file, or PIF file.

Tasks



By pressing the Tasks button you have access to the following things:

Listbox

This listbox contains the list of all the currently executing applications. Entries prefixed with 'h' means they are hidden applications.

Switch To

This button allows you to switch to the application selected in the listbox.

Terminate

This button allows you to stop the application selected in the list box from further execution.

Minimize

This button allows you to minimize the application selected in the list box to an icon.

Maximize

This button allows you maximize the application selected in the list box to use the full screen.

Restore

This button will restore the application selected in the listbox to the position it was before it was either minimized or maximized. This is needed if you minimize or maximize an application that will not let you, then you need to restore it.

Cascade

This button will cascade all the open applications that you have on your desktop.

Tile

This button will tile all the open applications that you have on your desktop.

Arrange Icons

This button will arrange applications that are icons on the Windows desktop.

Hide

This button will hide the application selected in the list box from view.

Show

This button will unhide (show) the hidden application selected in the list box.

Put On Top

This button will make the application selected in the list box the application that is on top of all other applications even if it is not the active application.

Take Off Top

This button will make the application selected in the list box that is on top of all other applications no longer able to stay on top of all other applications.

Center

This button will center the application selected in the list box on the screen. This comes is handy when you switch video modes and some of your applications are displayed outside the new screen coordinates. Select a task, then press the "center" button to bring it to the center of the screen. Now you can reposition it to where you like. Center will not work on iconized applications. You must restore them to normal size to use center.

Update

This button will update the task listbox if you are working on multiple applications.

Close Only On OK

This option allows the dialog box to stay open, if it is selected, so you can manipulate other tasks if you need to.

Watching Windows memory consists of the following things:

GDI

This represents the percentage of free memory that Windows has for drawing any and all graphics to the screen. This includes device-context handles, brushes, pens, regions, fonts, and bitmaps.

System

This represents the percentage of free memory that Windows has for system resources.

User

This represents the percentage of free memory that Windows has for user resources, which includes window and menu handles.

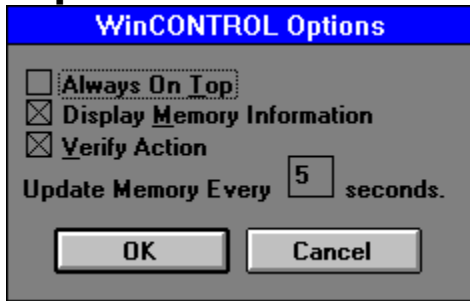
Free

This represents the number of kilobytes (x1024) of free memory that an application has to work with.

Avail

This represents the number of kilobytes (x1024) of the biggest block of free memory that an application can allocate to work with.

Options



WinCONTROL's options can be accessed from the control menu under "Options" and has the following options:

Always On Top

Makes WinCONTROL's window the window that is on top of all other applications even if it is not the active application.

Display Memory Information

If this option is selected, WinCONTROL will watch Windows memory, otherwise it will not.

Verify Action

If this option is selected, then whenever you want to execute a critical step, you will be prompted. For example, if you chose the Windows button, then the Exit Windows button, you would be prompted to verify that you wanted to exit Windows. If it is not chosen, then you will not be prompted for verification.

Update Memory Every XX seconds

Lets you choose how long, in seconds, that Windows memory information is updated.

Registration

WinCONTROL is fairly inexpensive. You can choose from the following two options:

Option 1

Send **\$15** US dollars for registration. You will be kept informed about all updates and new products.

Option 2

Send **\$25** US dollars for registration and you will also be sent a stand alone version of the "**Tasks**" feature to replace the **Windows Task Manager**, and a registered copy of the next version when it becomes available. You will be informed about all new updates and new products.

about Shareware

Shareware distribution gives users a chance to try software before buying it. If you try a Shareware program and continue using it, you are expected to register. Individual programs differ on details -- some request registration while others require it, some specify a maximum trial period. With registration, you get anything from the simple right to continue using the software to an updated program with printed manual.

Copyright laws apply to both Shareware and commercial software, and the copyright holder retains all rights, with a few specific exceptions as stated below. Shareware authors are accomplished programmers, just like commercial authors, and the programs are of comparable quality. (In both cases, there are good programs and bad ones!) The main difference is in the method of distribution. The author specifically grants the right to copy and distribute the software, either to all and sundry or to a specific group. For example, some authors require written permission before a commercial disk vendor may copy their Shareware.

Shareware is a distribution method, not a type of software. You should find software that suits your needs and pocketbook, whether it's commercial or Shareware. The Shareware system makes fitting your needs easier, because you can try before you buy. And because the overhead is low, prices are low also. Shareware has the ultimate money-back guarantee -- if you don't use the product, you don't pay for it.

DISCLAIMER - AGREEMENT

Users of WinCONTROL must accept this disclaimer of warranty:

"WinCONTROL is supplied as is. The author disclaims all warranties, expressed or implied, including, without limitation, the warranties of merchantability and of fitness for any purpose. The author assumes no liability for damages, direct or consequential, which may result from the use of WinCONTROL."

WinCONTROL is a "shareware program" and is provided at no charge to the user for evaluation. Feel free to share it with your friends, but please do not give it away altered or as part of another system. The essence of "user-supported" software is to provide personal computer users with quality software without high prices, and yet to provide incentive for programmers to continue to develop new products. If you find this program useful and find that you are using WinCONTROL and continue to use WinCONTROL after a reasonable trial period, you must register (see "Registration" for more information). Registration gives you a license for one copy for use on any one computer at any one time. You must treat this software just like a book. An example is that this software may be used by any number of people and may be freely moved from one computer location to another, so long as there is no possibility of it being used at one location

while it's being used at another. Just as a book cannot be read by two different persons at the same time.

Commercial users of WinCONTROL must register and pay for their copies of WinCONTROL within 21 days of first use or their license is withdrawn. Site-License arrangements may be made by contacting Luhan Software.

Anyone distributing WinCONTROL for any kind of remuneration must first contact Luhan Software at the address below for authorization. This authorization will be automatically granted to distributors, and such distributors may begin offering WinCONTROL immediately (However Luhan Software must still be advised so that the distributor can be kept up-to-date with the latest version of WinCONTROL).

You are encouraged to pass a copy of WinCONTROL along to your friends for evaluation. Please encourage them to register their copy if they find that they can use it.

These are just some of the features scheduled to be put into version 2.0:

Control Panel Plus

Control Panel Plus is an addition to the Windows Control Panel. Among the items you will be able to change are Icon fonts, Icon Vertical Spacing, Windows Help colors, plus more.

Improved Task Manager

Among the improvements to the Task Manager are manipulating multiple tasks, getting task information, and getting window information.

Register NOW

At the moment there are no other products out on shareware, but here is a list of the products under development:

MS-DOS Power Tools

A collection of utilities that either replace or supplement MS-DOS utilities and commands. A sampling of the tools included are :

A DIR replacement that allows you to intuitively handle directory listings. A few of its features are file type color coding, full, short, and custom listings; and scrolling.

COPY, DELETE, MOVE and MD replacements that allow multiple files to be handled on the command line.

A CD replacement that allows changing to drives and directories (i.e. "cd d:\tools\luhan") plus has a window where most used directories can be stored. Access is fast with this.

An EDIT replacement that works with multiple files plus has a calculator, ascii chart, and color chart.

A MORE replacement that works in a more usable manner.

An RD replacement that allows removing directory trees.

PathAdd to append paths to your PATH statement.

Rendir to rename directories.

IconBar

A Windows utility that allows you to have the most commonly used program icons available quickly. Features include drag and drop add, execute applications by dropping files onto icons, support for groups of icons and can replace the Windows Program Manager. This one is hot and should be out real soon.

ED

A replacement for Windows NotePad. It can handle multiple files, fonts, tabs, word wrap, drag and drop editing, and more. Also available soon.
