About e-mail notify

I wrote e-mail notify because I connect my home computer to the school computers through a PPP link and a 14,4k modem. I wanted to keep my mail folders on the school computer because it is the only way I can access them from both school and home. For this reason, I needed a windows program that tells when there is new mail without retrieving it and without taking to much of the sockets bandwidth.

e-mail notify has the ability to check for mail on your pop-server and will get the headers of any mail you have waiting for you. e-mail notify can check for you regularly on the pop server. e-mail notify will never retrieve, nor delete the mail from the pop server. You will need another program to read the incoming mail. e-mail notify will use windows 95's new shell features to be more intergrated in the user interface. You will see the red icon of e-mail notify in the Tray in the right part of the Taskbar of Windows 95. You are able to configure control e-mail notify with right and left mouse clicks on this icon.

Some of you, who have a windows 95 or NT or Win32s computer connected directly to the Internet, might be able to use e-mail notify in conjunction with another e-mail windows application.

This is the second alpha release of e-mail notify. Three different version of this app are distribbuted. One for Windows 95 and Windows NT 3.51 and later versions. One for Windows NT 3.5 and previous versions (maybe), and finally one for Win32s.

Only the version for Windows 95 has been really tested, and it was with build 347 of the Windows 95 beta. The other version have been quickly tested by myself and some people who were interested in these versions.

The Win32s version is not has easy to use as the Multi-Threaded versions for Windows 95 and Windows NT. I do not have much time to make the app better for these system. I just did a quick port, because someone promised me some beautifull Australian Postcards :).

The program is currently an e-mail or postcard-ware, which means the only thing you will have to do, to get the right of using this program is to send me an e-mail or a beautifull postcard of your country. See the [copyright information](#) for more information.

Which version do I have

If you are not sure of the version you are using here is how to discover it:

If the application doesn't start in Win32s, this means that you are trying to use the wrong version. You have to get the Win32s Non-Multi-Threaded version. Please check out on my World Wide Web site <http://www-stud.enst.fr/dubost/french/email.html>

If you are running Windows NT 3.5 (of 3.1), and the app doesn't start, you have to get the Windows NT 3.5 specific version on my WWW site.

Finally, with Windows 95, Windows NT 3.51 or later, all versions will run. To be sure to run the version using the specific features of Windows 95 and Windows NT 3.51, check out the about box to see if it says: "e-Mail Notify for Windows 95"

How to force e-mail header transfer

To force e-mail transfer, you have to clear the e-mail notify window with the Clear command in the File menu, and the ask notify to check for mail with the Check mail command of the Mail menu.

How use the Command-Line arguments

e-Mail Notify has now command-line arguments. The two command-line arguments are:

/H To start e-Mail Notify Hidden in Windows 95.

/Sn To choose alternate settings for e-mail notify.

Notes:

Do not use the /H switch in Windows NT or Win32s. You would not be able to find the app again. The /Sn switch is usefull if you want to run concurrent notifiers for different mailboxes. It will store all information in different places in the registry.
