

Remote Access Configuration

The Remote Access Configuration dialog allows you to:

- Select the **COM port** for your modem.
- Select model of your **modem**.
- Enable or disable the Remote Access protocol.

If you enable/disable Remote Access, you will have to reboot your computer to put the change into effect.

To set the COM port:

1. Select the arrow scroll bar at the end of the COM Port box.
2. Highlight COM1 or COM2, depending on your modem connection.

If you select a port that is in use or is not installed, you will be prompted to verify your selection.

To set the modem type:

1. Select the arrow scroll bar at the end of the Modem box.
2. Scroll through the list of modems until you find the model of your modem.
3. Highlight the name of your modem.

To enable Remote Access:

1. Click the Enable Remote Access check box so that it contains an X.
2. Select the <OK> button.
3. Choose whether to restart your computer now to enable Remote Access (<Restart Computer>) or to postpone this change until later (<Continue>).

To disable Remote Access:

1. Click the Enable Remote Access check box so that it is empty (no X).
2. Select the <OK> button.
3. Choose whether to restart your computer now to disable Remote Access (<Restart Computer>) or to postpone this change until later (<Continue>).
