

Microsoft(R) Windows NT(TM) NetWare(R) Workstation Compatible Service Microsoft Services for NetWare in Windows NT

The number one request from customers using the Windows NT(TM) operating system is to be able to connect to NetWare(R) servers. Enclosed please find the update disk that contains the Client Service for NetWare to be used with your existing Windows NT 3.1 system. Client Service for NetWare will connect your Windows NT-based desktop to the file and print services on your Novell(R) NetWare 2.x, 3.x, and 4.x servers through bindery emulation. It also supports many of the NetWare 2.x and 3.x administrative utilities and the most commonly used NetWare-aware applications, such as Lotus Notes(R) and Novell NetWare SAA(TM) . See the documentation on Client Service for NetWare for further details on what is supported.

This package also includes Microsoft Gateway Service for NetWare Servers for your Windows NT(TM) Advanced Server systems. This gateway enables Microsoft networking clients to access files on NetWare servers through Windows NT Advanced Server. The Gateway Service is only available on Windows NT Advanced Server. The gateway is an integration tool for those desktops that don't have NetWare client software but need intermittent access to files or printers on NetWare servers. NetWare administrators continue to have complete control over who can access the file and print services on their NetWare servers. Windows(TM) for Workgroups, however, is the recommended software for desktops that frequently need to connect to both NetWare and Microsoft Windows NT Advanced Servers.

Addendum to the Microsoft License Agreement for Microsoft Windows NT

Microsoft Corporation ("Microsoft") grants to you the nonexclusive, nonassignable right to use the enclosed Microsoft software in conjunction with your Windows NT-based desktop or Windows NT Advanced Servers. Upon installation, these files are subject to the same license terms and conditions as the Windows NT product you previously acquired from Microsoft Corporation. Any other use of these files is prohibited.

Installing Client and Gateway Service for NetWare

You must first install the minimum of the Microsoft Windows NT and Windows NT Advanced Server Service Pack 1 (though the latest version is highly recommended) before installing the Client Service for NetWare. Installation of the

Service Pack will maintain system settings and user groups, and is quickly and easily accomplished. It is not necessary to back up your system, user groups, or accounts. The latest Service Pack (Service Pack 2) and Client Service for NetWare are available at no extra charge on CompuServe(R) and the Internet. Or, customers can call Microsoft to order Service Pack 2, and the Service for NetWare fulfillment pack for \$14.95 each for freight and handling. The Service for NetWare fulfillment pack includes both the Client and Gateway Service for NetWare for Windows NT and Windows NT Advanced Server.

At the Windows NT command, insert Disk 1 of the Service Pack disk set into the floppy drive, change your command prompt to that drive, and type UPDATE. The Setup program will be invoked to guide you through the update procedure, prompting for each disk until the update is complete. This process will take approximately 8 minutes. Please note that this procedure applies to x86 systems only. The Service Pack is available for MIPS(R); details are in the Support Notes, under "Before you begin." DEC(R) Alpha AXPTM systems do not require this Service Pack and should already be running the Alpha AXP retail release. Please note the README.TXT on Disk 1 of the Service Pack for further information.

NOTE: You must first remove any existing versions of Microsoft's or Novell's redirector for Windows NT before installing Client Service for NetWare. Please see the section "Removing Existing Redirector Installations" in the Client Service for NetWare document in your kit.

Your Guide to Service and Support

Client Service for NetWare and Gateway Service for NetWare are additional services that run on your existing Windows NT and Windows NT Advanced Server version 3.1, respectively. Therefore, your existing support policy for Windows NT and Windows NT Advanced Server apply.

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
