Navigating through the main menu

The main menu contains a list of groups which contain different kinds of items. Use your mouse or the cursor keys to select the group of your choice and press <Enter> or click the Open command to open the selected group.

You can use the following commands:

- Open: Opens the selected group at that moment
- Language: Selects the language in which SilverMenu works
- Shareware: Information about the Shareware concept
- Help: Gives help while working with the SilverMenu program
- Exit: Closes the SilverMenu program

Navigating through a group

A group is a collection of items, which you can select in the main menu. You can start every item in a group with the Run command. Items can also be copied by using the Copy command. Click on the Information button to ask for a brief description of the selected item. Use the Documentation button for more complete information about the selected item.

You can use the following commands:

Run: Runs the selected item.

Info: Gives a short description of the selected item, if available.

Documentation: Shows the documentation of the selected item, if available.

Stop: Stops MIDI or Wave replay (this command is only available when playing MIDI or Wave audio).

Copy: Copies the selected item.

Main menu: Returns to the main menu.

Note: If you start an application, keep in mind that in Windows several applications can be active at the same time. So it is possible to start a program while a previously started program is still active. If many applications are active at the same time, the system will become slower and memory problems could occur. Make sure that there are not too many applications active at the same time in order to get the best performance.

The Shareware concept

The Silver Label™ CD-ROM's contain, among others, Shareware software. Shareware software is not free software. You are permitted to test the software during a predefined period (mostly about 30 days), if you want to continue to use the software after this evaluation period, you must register the software. Selecting a language

The SilverMenu program is multilingual, you can choose in which language you want the program to operate. To change the language, click on the "Language" button in the main menu. At this moment, available languages are English, French, German and Dutch. The selected language will be remembered so that this and other Silver Label CD-ROMs will continue to use the selected language until you change it again.

Copying an item

To copy an item, select it and click on the Copy button. You will be asked for a destination, please select the path to which you want to copy the selected item. You can also make a directory, to do this, click on the Make dir button. If the path is entered correctly, click the OK button to start copying.

Make directory

Select the Make Directory command if you want to make a directory to copy one or more items from the CD-ROM to. Enter the name of directory you want to make and click on the OK button to make the directory. Click on the Cancel button if you do not want to make a directory.
