Main Window

The Main Window of My Life Database Maintenance is where My Life databases can be <u>compressed</u>, <u>repaired</u>, and <u>deleted</u>. Compressing a database can reduce the amount of disk space the database is using. If a My Life database gets corrupted, the repair My Life option may fix the damage. A backup database is created when a database is compressed. The backup database is to provide a backout in case a newly compressed database does not work properly. If the newly compressed works properly, the backup database can be <u>deleted</u> to free up disk space.

The EXIT button will end My Life Database Maintenance.

NOTE: When using My Life Database Maintenance, pop-up help text can be displayed for an item by placing the mouse pointer over the item and holding the right mouse button down.

The about window displays the copyright notice and the version release number of My Life. Click on the About Window to close the window.

Compress My Life Window

The Compress My Life Window is where a My Life database can be selected to be compressed. Compressing a database can free up disk space used by the database. When a database is compressed, a backup of the database is created before the compression.

The COMPRESS MY LIFE button will compress the selected database and create a backup database.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.

Delete My Life Backup Window

The Delete My Life Backup Window displays a list of all My Life backup databases. These backup databases can be deleted to free up disk space.

The DELETE MY LIFE BACKUP button will delete the selected backup My Life database.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.

The Repair My Life Window is where a corrupted My Life database can possibly be fixed.

The REPAIR MY LIFE button will run a repair process on the selected database.
