FOURTH LINE - The availability of a restaurant or a cocktail lounge. "On premises" means under the same roof as the motel. "Nearby" typically means within walking distance or a 1-2 minute drive.

If a motel is listed as "No adjacent restaurant", it is still reasonable to assume that a restaurant is located within a few minutes driving time in all but the most remote locations.
