Description:

PrinterPal is a hack to print files w/o having to first open the document's application and hassle w/ a Print panel. To print a currently supported file, drag the document over PrinterPal's application icon and drop.

PrinterPal is most useful when you want to print multiple documents... simply drag multiple (*deck of cards*) documents on top of the app icon.

PrinterPal will print the following types of files...

.wn, .tiff, .ps, .eps, .rtf[d] and any text files (don't worry, PrinterPal will correctly wrap long lines)

It's not all too robust, but is a good (enough?) as a demo.

Caveat...

 don't print .wn files which are really file packages... in reality, .wn files are first converted to rtf and then printed (this conversion results in the lack of headers/footers/footnotes and some formatting in the final output±such as multicolumn output)
