Actually File Flush is a relatively simple program. It initializes as a toilet icon with a closed lid. As soon as you drag and 'drop' a file into the toilet, you'll hear a splash and the lid will open. Don't worry though, the files are still safe (maybe a bit damp) until you can make a final decision on them. Remember, if the toilet lid is close you have not dropped any files in. If the toilet lid is closed, the bowl is empty. Double-Click on the icon to dispose of the files.

A small window with two buttons appears, **FLUSH** or **RESTORE** with appropriate icons. If you click **FLUSH** by accident, don't panic! You will have to verify you wish to flush the files to sea. Once verified the toilet will flush, you'll hear it, and the files will be gone. You'll also note the icons will change to the universal "NO" symbols meaning that no files exist to flush or restore.

If you click the **RESTORE** button, you'll hear a splash as you dip your mouse into the toilet to investigate what files are there. The Restore window will open which gives you a listing of the files that you have dropped into the toilet. You can click on a file then **OK** to restore that one file or like the file manager select a range or any group of files by adding the *SHIFT* or *CONTROL* keys with your clicks. Note you can also **RESTORE ALL** or **CANCEL** the restore operation. **OK**, **CANCEL**, and **RESTORE ALL** close the window and return to the flush window.

Click the Control Button to Minimize the Flush Window back to an icon and awaiting your next dump.

Behind the scenes: When File Flush Initializes it creates a directory to temporarily store your dropped files. If you shut down Windows before flushing, the next invocation of flush will show those files still present. That is, the toilet lid will be open indicating the presence of files. FLUSH must have access to the *SPLASH.WAV* and *FLUSH.WAV* files included in the ZIP file for FLUSH to make the splash and flush sounds.
